 - **12-43.3-501. Marijuana cash fund.** (1) (b) Moneys MONEY in the fund are IS subject to annual appropriation by the general assembly to:
 - (I) The department of revenue for the direct and indirect costs associated with implementing this article, article 43.4 of this title, and article 28.8 of title 39, C.R.S.; AND
 - (II) THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH IMPLEMENTING PART 2 OF ARTICLE 11.5 OF TITLE 35, C.R.S.
 - **SECTION 11. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2016-17 state fiscal year, \$65,640 is appropriated to the department of agriculture. This appropriation is from the marijuana cash fund created in section 12-43.3-501 (1) (a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
 - (a) \$37,137 for the plant industry division, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 0.5 FTE; and
 - (b) \$28,503 for the purchase of legal services.
 - (2) For the 2016-17 state fiscal year, \$28,503 is appropriated to the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the department of agriculture under paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will require an additional 0.2 FTE. To implement this act, the department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the department of agriculture.
