A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE SURGICAL ASSISTANT AND

102 SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST REGISTRATION PROGRAM.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Health, Insurance, and Environment Committee. The bill continues the requirement that surgical technicians and surgical assistants register with the director of the division of professions and occupations in the department of regulatory agencies.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 12-43.2-107
3	as follows:
4	12-43.2-107. Repeal of article. This article is repealed, effective
5	September 1, 2016 2021. Prior to such repeal, the registration of surgical
6	assistants and surgical technologists shall be reviewed as provided in
7	section 24-34-104, C.R.S.
8	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, repeal
9	(47.5) (b); and add (52.5) (f) as follows:
10	24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies
11	and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.
12	(47.5) The following agencies, functions, or both, shall terminate on
13	September 1, 2016:
14	(b) The registration of surgical assistants and surgical
15	technologists pursuant to article 43.2 of title 12, C.R.S.;
16	(52.5) The following agencies, functions, or both, terminate on
17	September 1, 2021:
18	(f) THE REGISTRATION OF SURGICAL ASSISTANTS AND SURGICAL
19	TECHNOLOGISTS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 43.2 OF TITLE 12, C.R.S.
20	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
21	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
22	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
23	10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except that, if a
24	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
25	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
26	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
27	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
