Points to Consider

Technical Note

Appropriation adjustments related to the elimination of the Property Tax Reimbursement for Property Destroyed by Natural Causes program have been made in the Long Bill supplemental and Long Bill. The changes reflect appropriation reductions of \$0.5 million General Fund in FY 2024-25 and a reduction of \$1.0 million General Fund in FY 2025-26 to the Department of Treasury.
