CONCERNING AN EXTENSION OF THE TIME FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WILD HORSE POPULATION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-1-119, amend (2) as follows:

35-1-119. Wild horse population management - repeal. (2) This section is repealed, effective July 31, 2024 DECEMBER 31, 2025.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
