Bill Summary

The bill authorizes a person with a club license (licensee) that allows the sale of alcohol beverages by the drink to members of the club and their guests for consumption on the premises of the club to:

- Commingle any donated alcohol beverages with the licensee's inventory of alcohol beverages; and
- Retain and sell donated alcohol beverages that remain on the licensee's premises after a special event.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-3-418, add (2)(c) 3 as follows: 4 44-3-418. Club license - legislative declaration. (2) (c) THE 5 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION (2) DO NOT PROHIBIT A CLUB 6 LICENSEE FROM ACQUIRING ALCOHOL BEVERAGES THROUGH DONATION 7 AND SELLING DONATED ALCOHOL BEVERAGES AS AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 8 44-5-109. 9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 44-5-109 as follows: 10 11 44-5-109. Donated alcohol beverages - authority of club 12 licensee to retain and sell. (1) IF ALCOHOL BEVERAGES ARE DONATED TO 13 THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FOR A SPECIAL EVENT HELD ON 14 THE PREMISES OF A PERSON LICENSED UNDER SECTION 44-3-418: 15 (a) NEITHER THE HOLDER OF THE SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT NOR THE 16 PERSON LICENSED UNDER SECTION 44-3-418 IS REQUIRED TO STORE THE 17 DONATED ALCOHOL BEVERAGES SEPARATELY FROM THE LICENSEE'S 18 INVENTORY; AND 19 (b) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 44-3-418 (2), THE PERSON 20 LICENSED UNDER SECTION 44-3-418 MAY KEEP ANY DONATED ALCOHOL 21 BEVERAGES REMAINING AFTER THE SPECIAL EVENT AND SELL THE 22 ALCOHOL BEVERAGES BY THE DRINK ONLY TO MEMBERS OF THE CLUB AND MEMBERS' GUESTS AND ONLY FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED 23

SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date - applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

(2) This act applies to special event permits issued on or after the applicable effective date of this act.
