TERMINOLOGY REFERENCING "RIGHTS OF MARRIED WOMEN"

Summary of **Fiscal Impact:**  No Fiscal Impact. This bill replaces statutory language referring to the "rights of married women" to "the rights of married persons" to be more inclusive. It has no

fiscal impact on state or local government.

## **Summary of Legislation**

This bill replaces statutory references to the "rights of married women" to the "rights of married persons" to be more inclusive.

### **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

Based on Colorado case law and other statutes, spouses have equal treatment in regards to property rights and other individual rights. Therefore, updating statutory language to more contemporary terminology will have no impact on the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government, and, therefore, is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 29, 2018, and takes effect August 8, 2018, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
