Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies

in its sunset review of the Colorado special education fiscal advisory committee by continuing the committee indefinitely.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-20-114.5, repeal 3 (2)(c) as follows: 4 22-20-114.5. Special education fiscal advisory committee -5 special education high-cost grants - definitions - repeal. (2) (c) This 6 subsection (2) is repealed, effective September 1, 2021. Before its repeal, 7 the committee is scheduled for review in accordance with section 8 2-3-1203, C.R.S. 9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 10 (12)(a)(IV) as follows: 11 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 12 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (12) (a) The following statutory 13 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on 14 September 1, 2021: 15 (IV) The Colorado special education fiscal advisory committee 16 created in section 22-20-114.5 (2), C.R.S.; 17 **SECTION 3.** Effective date. This act takes effect September 1, 18 2021. 19 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 21 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
