Wildfire Matters Review Committee. The division of fire prevention and control is currently required to host the wildfire information and resource center website and to provide information regarding active wildfires on the website. 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1230, add 3 (5) as follows: 4 **24-33.5-1230.** Wildfire information and resource center. (5) IN 5 ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS IN SUBSECTION (2)(b) OF THIS SECTION, 6 THE CENTER'S WEBSITE MUST ALSO INCLUDE HYPERLINKS TO WEBSITES 7 THAT DISPLAY EMERGENCY INFORMATION AND WILDFIRE UPDATES FOR 8 EACH COUNTY IN COLORADO. THE DIVISION SHALL COORDINATE WITH 9 COUNTY GOVERNMENTS IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THE HYPERLINKS REQUIRED 10 BY THIS SUBSECTION (5). 11 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 12 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 14 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 15 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 16 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 17 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 18 November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 19 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
