9	(B) The applicant has had at least three years of continuous,

1	a special services provider in an established elementary or secondary
2	school and can provide documentation of such experience on forms

SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 1 2 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a 4 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 6 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 8 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 9 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.". 10
