This bill would have allowed a local governing body to vote to reject or modify a health order. Local governments that would have chosen to vote on such a matter would have had an increase in expenditures.

## Summary of Legislation

This bill allows a local governing body to vote to reject or modify a health order issued by a county or district public health agency, public health director, or board of health.

## Local Government

Local governments that choose to consider rejecting or modifying a public health order will have an increase in expenditures to hold a hearing and vote.

## Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Committee on Public and Behavioral Health and Human Services on March 5, 2021.
