#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides a total of \$2,817,327 to the Department of Human Services for FY 2018-19, including \$2,267,261 federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant funds and \$550,066 cash funds from local funds. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.9 FTE.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### Future Fiscal Impact

The Department of Education is required to implement the Educational Stability Grant Program and hire a full-time foster care education coordinator in FY 2019-20. The Department of Education will require an appropriation of \$1,060,865 General Fund for FY 2019-20 for the implementation of Sections 2 and 3 of the bill.
