A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF MEMBERS OF BOARDS OF HEALTH,
102	AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REGULATING THE MEMBERS
103	OF COUNTY AND DISTRICT BOARDS OF HEALTH.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill specifies that members of a county or district board of health are not allowed to serve concurrently as members of a board of county commissioners and as members of a county or district board of health. The bill also allows members of a county or district board of health to be removed for malfeasance or other specified reasons.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1-508, add (7),
3	(8), and (9) as follows:
4	25-1-508. County or district boards of public health - public
5	health directors. (7) Members of a county board of health or a
6	DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH SHALL ATTEND ANNUAL PUBLIC HEALTH
7	TRAINING PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND
8	ENVIRONMENT AND DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH
9	AND ENVIRONMENT ALONG WITH THE COLORADO SCHOOL OF PUBLIC
10	HEALTH.
11	(8) The department of public health and environment
12	SHALL PROVIDE GUIDANCE ON RECRUITING PERSONS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE
13	AND WILLING TO SERVE ON COUNTY AND DISTRICT BOARDS OF HEALTH.
14	THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT SHALL PROVIDE
15	THE GUIDANCE IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT TO ANY BOARD OF COUNTY

24	of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
25	act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
26	effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
