Summary Information

Overview. The bill adds private, nonprofit hospitals to the list of facilities allowed to enter into collaborative agreements.

Summary of Legislation

Current law allows certain public hospitals with fewer than 50 beds to enter into collaborative agreements to increase access to health care. This bill adds private, non-profit hospitals and hospitals with fewer than 50 beds to the list of facilities approved to enter into collaborative agreements.

State Expenditures

Workload will minimally increase for the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing, Department of Regulatory Agencies, and Department of Law to evaluate any additional collaborative agreements submitted by hospitals. This workload is expected to be minimal and can be absorbed within existing resources.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 7, 2025, and takes effect on August 6, 2025, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
