#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

- **J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$20,865 to the Department of Revenue for FY 2018-19, including an increase of \$26,141 cash funds from the Colorado DRIVES Vehicle Services Account and a decrease of \$5,276 cash funds from the Licensing Services Cash Fund, and reappropriating \$16,016 to the Governor's Office of Information Technology. This provision also states that the Department of Revenue's related FTE will decrease by 0.3 FTE.
- **L.001** Bill Sponsor amendment **L.001** (attached) strikes the House Transportation and Energy Committee Report (01/31/18) to change the start date from January 31, 2019 to January 1, 2019, and removes a provision referencing the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account which is replaced by the Colorado DRIVES Vehicle Services Account effective
