	The bill requires the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing to seek a federal grant for certified community behavioral health clinics. The bill minimally increases state workload.		
Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation is required.		
Fiscal Note Status:	The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Joint Budget Committee.		

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) to seek a federal grant for certified community behavioral health clinics. The bill specifies that HCPF must collaborate with the Behavioral Health Administration (BHA) and the Joint Budget Committee. If the grant is received, HCPF must promulgate rules to certify the clinics.

State Expenditures

Workload will minimally increase for HCPF to seek the grant. If HCPF receives the grant, workload will increase to promulgate rules and expenditures will increase as HCPF expends the funds received. The amount of potential grant funding is unknown at this time.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
