BILL TOPIC: COMMUNITY-MILITARY COOPERATION

Summary of Legislation

This bill encourages partnerships between military installations and the communities that host them to explore areas of mutual benefit in the provision of shared services. It also identifies the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) as the appropriate state agency to support such partnerships, which it will do through existing programs.

Local Government Impact

Local communities are encouraged to work with military installations to explore areas of mutual benefit and shared services. Local communities that choose to pursue these partnerships may see an increased workload for the provision of shared services. These communities may also realize a cost savings from any efficiencies gained through the provision of shared services. If local governments seek support through DOLA, it is expected that any support will be provided through existing programs, and no additional appropriations are required for this purpose.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 9, 2017, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 10, 2017, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
