A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXCLUSION OF MARIJUANA FROM THE DEFINITION OF "FARM PRODUCTS" WITH REGARD TO REGULATION OF FARM PRODUCTS UNDER THE "FARM PRODUCTS ACT".

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under the "Farm Products Act", the commissioner of agriculture or his or her designee licenses farm product dealers, small-volume dealers, and their agents. The bill excludes marijuana from the definition of "farm products" under the act.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-16-103, amend
3	(5)(b); and add (5.3) and (5.7) as follows:
4	12-16-103. Definitions - rules. As used in this part 1, unless the
5	context otherwise requires:
6	(5) (b) "Farm products" does not include poultry and poultry
7	products, timber products, nursery stock, or commodities, OR MARIJUANA.
8	(5.3) "Industrial Hemp" means a plant of the genus
9	CANNABIS AND ANY PART OF THE PLANT, WHETHER GROWING OR NOT,
10	CONTAINING A DELTA-9 TETRAHYDROCANNABINOL CONCENTRATION OF
11	NO MORE THAN THREE-TENTHS OF ONE PERCENT ON A DRY WEIGHT BASIS.
12	(5.7) (a) "Marijuana" has the same meaning as set forth in
13	SECTION 27-80-203 (15).
14	(b) "MARIJUANA" DOES NOT INCLUDE INDUSTRIAL HEMP.
15	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
16	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
17	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
18	9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a
19	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
20	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
21	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
22	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
23	November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
24	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
