Right to Be Born Constitutional Amendment, 2025-2026

In the constitution of the state of Colorado, add section 33 to Article II as follows:

Section 33. RIGHT TO BE BORN.

CHILDREN HAVE THE RIGHT TO CONTINUE LIVING FROM THE MOMENT OF BEING CONCEIVED. GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT DENY, IMPEDE, OR DISCRIMINATE AGAINST THE EXERCISE OF THAT RIGHT, INCLUDING DISCRIMINATING IN LAW AGAINST A CHILD WHO DUE TO AGE HAS NOT YET BEEN BORN, PERMITTING BUSINESSES TO OPERATE THAT INTENTIONALLY END THE LIVES OF CHILDREN, FORCING TAXPAYERS TO PAY FOR ENDING THE LIVES OF CHILDREN, OR ALLOWING DRUGS IN THE STATE INTENDED TO END THE LIVES OF CHILDREN.

Self-Executing. This provision of lawful protection shall be self-executing, meaning it does not need the governor's signature, and shall supersede any conflicting statutes, legislation, or judgments.

- a) Applicability. This act of protection applies beginning November 4, 2026, and is not retroactive, meaning that this act does not apply to actions prior to November 4, 2026.
- b) Effective Date. This act shall take effect November 4, 2026, if approved by the vote of the people.
- c) Severability. If any part of the act is found to be unenforceable, the remainder of this act shall remain in effect.

In the constitution of the state of Colorado, repeal section 32 to Article II.
