Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$1,575 cash funds from the Licensing Services Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2019-20. The Fiscal Note identifies an appropriation from the Colorado DRIVES Vehicle Services Account, however Legislative Council Staff agrees that the appropriation should be from the Licensing Services Cash Fund.
