	A BILL FOR AN ACT
101	CONCERNING PROVIDING FUNDING TO SCHOOLS IN THE 2023-24
102	BUDGET YEAR FOR INCREASES IN PUPIL ENROLLMENT AFTER THE
103	2023-24 BUDGET YEAR PUPIL ENROLLMENT COUNT DAY, AND, IN
104	CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov/.)

Joint Budget Committee. For the 2023-24 budget year, the bill appropriates \$24 million from the state education fund to the department of education (department) to distribute one-time funding to school

districts and institute charter schools that enrolled new arrival students after the 2023-24 pupil enrollment count day.

The bill provides to each school district and each institute charter school that requests funding pursuant to the bill:

- An amount determined by a tiered schedule that is based on the total number of new arrival students who enrolled in the school district or institute charter schools after the 2023-24 pupil enrollment count day; and
- \$4,500 for each student who is in the school district's or institute charter schools' total net student population; except that, if the amount appropriated is insufficient to meet the demand, the department is required to proportionately reduce the \$4,500 amount.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general assembly finds that:

- (a) A federal government directive requires that states provide a uniform public education that ensures equitable access to educational opportunities for all students, regardless of background or location. The directive's goal is to promote consistency in educational standards, curriculum, and resources across the states in order to foster a level field for all students.
- (b) During the 2024 legislative session, the general assembly accounted for the mid-year adjustment in school funding for the 2023-24 budget year, resulting in a decrease of \$23,964,790 to the state share of total program funding, which amount remained in the state education fund;
- (c) Pursuant to section 22-54-103 (10.5), Colorado Revised Statutes, the annual pupil enrollment count day generally occurs on October 1 of each budget year. The annual pupil enrollment count day is when school districts and institute charter schools count their students,

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charter school receives for the budget year.
(d) Between October 1, 2023, and February 29, 2024, Colorado
experienced an unprecedented influx of new arrival students enrolling in
schools across the state;
(e) The influx of new arrival students highlights the critical need
for increased funding. This sudden influx has strained existing school
infrastructure and staffing, led to overcrowded classrooms, stretched
resources, and increased complexity to the student learning environment
Schools are scrambling to accommodate the influx.
(f) New arrival students face unique challenges, including
language barriers, cultural adjustments, and various academic
backgrounds. These unique challenges require specialized resources and
support services.
(2) Therefore, the general assembly declares that additional
funding is essential to provide the services necessary to address the needs
of new arrival students and to ensure that existing students enrolled in
Colorado schools have access to the teachers, support staff, class sizes
and facilities necessary to learn without compromising educational
outcomes and student well-being.
SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 22-54-147 as
follows:

17	SECTION 3. Appropriation. For the 2023-24 state fiscal year,
18	\$24,000,000 is appropriated to the department of education. This
19	appropriation is from the state education fund created in section 17 (4)(a)
20	of article IX of the state constitution. To implement this act, the
21	department may use this appropriation for new arrival students funding
22	pursuant to section 22-54-147, C.R.S.
23	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
24	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
25	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
26	the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
27	institutions.

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
