Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$13,894 General Fund to the Department of Local Affairs for FY 2018-19. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE.

L.006 Sponsor amendment L.006 strikes the language that was added stating that the Department of Local Affairs shall staff the Task Force using existing resources. If the Committee adopts L.006 it should also adopt J.001.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The general appropriations bill for FY 2018-19 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$13,894 for FY 2018-19, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other purposes.
