After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB22-1407 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 19 through 25 and substitute:
"(2) An institution of higher education that has a program or policy that permits a person to audit a course offered by the institution for no credit shall, as part of the institution's program or policy, permit a veteran to audit a course for no credit, subject to any other requirements of the program or policy. The institution may set and collect a fee of no more than ten dollars per course audited by a veteran.  (3) The general assembly encourages each institution that does not have a program or policy that permits a person to audit a course offered by the institution for no credit to permit a veteran to audit a course for no credit. An institution that permits a veteran to audit a course shall not collect a fee of more than ten dollars per course."
Page 3, strike lines 1 through 5.
Page 3, after line 5, insert:
"(4) AN INSTITUTION THAT PERMITS A VETERAN TO AUDIT A COURSE FOR NO CREDIT IS NOT REQUIRED TO PERMIT A VETERAN TO AUDIT MORE THAN THREE COURSES IN EACH ACADEMIC SEMESTER FOR THE FEE OF UP TO TEN DOLLARS PER COURSE. AN INSTITUTION MAY PERMIT A VETERAN TO AUDIT ADDITIONAL COURSES FOR A FEE IN A DIFFERENT AMOUNT SET BY THE INSTITUTION.".
