Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$18,704 General Fund to the Department of Local Affairs for FY 2021-22. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE.

Points to Consider**Bills Requiring GF Appropriations:***General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package includes a set aside of \$50.0 million General Fund for bills that require General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$18,704 for FY 2021-22, reducing the \$50.0 million set aside by the same amount.
