Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$130,505 General Fund to the Department of Public Health and Environment for FY 2021-22. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.8 FTE. However, as identified in the Revised Fiscal Note, the bill is now anticipated to require an appropriation of \$108,984 General Fund, based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.6 FTE.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package includes a set aside of \$48.0 million General Fund for bills that require General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$108,984 for FY 2021-22, reducing the \$48.0 million set aside by the same amount.
