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Fiscal Assessment of L.001 to HB25-1168

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment L.001 to HB25-1168. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment only. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

Summary of Proposed Amendment

Amendment L.001 clarifies court procedures for the bill's new requirements for victim-survivors, including notifying the court about repayment plans, disclosing a tenant's victim-survivor status, requesting the suppression of court records, and other changes. Amendment L.001 also clarifies the effective date of certain provisions in the bill, including when the Judicial Department must make administrative updates to forms and processes.

Fiscal Impact of Amendment

Amendment L.001 eliminates the Judicial Department's costs to contract for system updates shown in the initial fiscal note. Workload to make the necessary administrative changes to comply with the bill's requirements can be accomplished by the new effective date of August 6, 2025 and within existing resources.

Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment

With Amendment L.001, the bill minimally affects workload in the Judicial Department and no longer requires an appropriation.
