Fiscal Summary of Initiative 202

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. A full fiscal impact statement for this initiative is or will be available at leg.colorado.gov/bluebook. This fiscal summary identifies the following impact.

State revenue and expenditures. This measure further codifies the ability of a candidate to access a ballot in Colorado through the caucus and assembly process of a political party. As this is the current practice, there is not estimated to be an increase to state revenue or expenditures.

Local government impact. Local municipalities and counties will continue to use their current voting processes and have no additional cost to comply with this measure.

Economic impacts. The measure has no direct impact on the state economy.
