Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$2,435,572 total funds to the Department of Revenue for FY 2016-17, including \$202,327 General Fund, \$2,043,976 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund, and \$189,269 from the License Plate Cash Fund. The amendment also reappropriates the entire amount, \$2,435,572, to the Colorado Correctional Industries in the Department of Corrections.
