

1 **SECTION 18. Appropriation to the department of health care**
2 **policy and financing for the fiscal year beginning July 1,**
3 **2019. Amend, as added by Senate Bill 21-043, section 3 (1)(e) as**
4 **follows:**

5 Section 3. **Appropriation to the department of health care**
6 **policy and financing for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019.**

7 (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$28,935,853 is appropriated to the
8 department of health care policy and financing and is for the payment of
9 overexpenditures of line item appropriations contained in Part V of
10 section 2 of chapter 454 (SB 19-207), Session Laws of Colorado 2019,
11 as follows:

12 (e) \$562,657 from the ~~children's basic health plan trust created in~~
13 ~~Section 25.5-8-105 (1), C.R.S.,~~ HEALTHCARE AFFORDABILITY AND
14 SUSTAINABILITY FEE CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION 25.5-4-402.4 (5)(a),
15 C.R.S., for children's basic health plan medical and dental costs;

16 **SECTION 19. Appropriation to the department of higher**
17 **education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020.** In Session Laws
18 of Colorado 2020, **amend** section 6 (2) of chapter 173, (HB 20-1385), as
19 follows:

20 Section 6. **Appropriation - adjustments to 2020 long bill.**

21 (2) To implement this act, appropriations made in the annual general

1 appropriation act for the 2020-21 state fiscal year to the department of
2 higher education are adjusted as follows:

3 (a) The general fund appropriation for fee-for-service contracts
4 with state institutions for specialty education programs is decreased by

6 (b) The appropriation for the regents of the university of Colorado
7 is reduced by ~~\$2,021,766~~; \$2,155,401. This appropriation is from
8 reappropriated funds received from the department of higher education
9 under subsection (2)(a) of this section.
