Sunset Process - Senate State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee. The bill continues the homeland security and all-hazards

senior advisory committee (committee) indefinitely by removing the repeal of the committee.

Homeland security and all-hazards senior 5 advisory committee - composition - duties - emergency planning 6 subcommittee - public safety communications subcommittee -7 creation - definitions. (4) (a) This section is repealed, effective 8 September 1, 2021. 9 (b) Prior to repeal, the department of regulatory agencies shall 10 review the advisory committee in accordance with section 2-3-1203, 11 C.R.S. 12 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 13 (12)(a)(I) as follows: 14 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 15 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (12) (a) The following statutory 16 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on 17 September 1, 2021: 18 The homeland security and all-hazards senior advisory 19 committee created in section 24-33.5-1614, C.R.S.; 20 **SECTION 3.** Effective date. This act takes effect September 1, 21 2021. 22 **SECTION 4.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 23 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 24 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
