

SECTION 1. In the constitution of the state of Colorado, add section 22 to article X as follows:

Section 22. Local control of property tax revenues. ANY VOTER INITIATIVE OR VOTER REFERENDUM THAT AFFECTS OR LIMITS THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUES OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT SHALL BE DECIDED ONLY IN A LOCAL ELECTION BY INDIVIDUALS ENTITLED TO VOTE IN THAT ELECTION. “LOCAL GOVERNMENT”, AS USED IN THIS SECTION, SHALL MEAN ANY CITY, COUNTY, SCHOOL DISTRICT, SPECIAL DISTRICT, OR ANY OTHER DISTRICT THAT RELIES ON PROPERTY TAXES FOR ALL OR A PORTION OF ITS REVENUES. THIS PROVISION SHALL SUPERSEDE ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS OF LAW.
