## 24-32-3315. Installers of manufactured homes and tiny homes - registration - fees - educational requirements - rules.

- (3) A person applying for registration or certification as an installer OR ON BEHALF OF A BUSINESS ENTITY TO PERFORM INSTALLATIONS, whether an initial or renewal application, must submit the application on a form provided by the division and verified by a declaration dated and signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury. The application must contain, in addition to any other information the division may reasonably require, the name, address, e-mail EMAIL address, and telephone number of the applicant. The division shall make the application and declaration available for public inspection.
- (4) In order to be registered initially as an installer OR TO HAVE A BUSINESS ENTITY REGISTERED TO PERFORM INSTALLATIONS, an applicant must:
- (5) A registration issued pursuant to this section is valid for one year from the date of issuance and cannot be transferred or assigned to another person OR BUSINESS ENTITY. The amount of the registration fee must be no more than two hundred fifty dollars. If any of the application information for the registered installer changes after the issuance of a registration, the registered installer must notify the division in writing within thirty days from the date of the change. The division may suspend, revoke, or deny renewal of a registration if the registered installer fails to notify the division of any change in the application.
- **SECTION 12. Appropriation.** For the 2025-26 state fiscal year, \$277,264 is appropriated to the department of local affairs for use by the division of housing. This appropriation is from the building regulation fund created in section 24-32-3309 (1)(a)(III), C.R.S., and is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 1.0 FTE. To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for manufactured buildings program."
