**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$463,729 General Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2019-20.

**Points to Consider***General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2019-20 based on the March 2019 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$65.2 million General Fund unallocated. Thus, the General Assembly could appropriate up to \$60.8 million General Fund to fund 2019 legislation and maintain a 7.25 percent General Fund reserve. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$463,729 for FY 2019-20, reducing the excess General Fund reserve by \$497,349.
