A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF USE OF A RENTAL MOTOR VEHICLE.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill limits the damages that a vehicle rental company can recover for the loss of use of the vehicle to the actual lost profits suffered by the company due to the loss of use of the vehicle.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 13-21-129 as
2	follows:
3	13-21-129. Civil damages related to rental motor vehicles. IN
4	ANY ACTION ALLEGING A CLAIM FOR THE LOSS OF USE OF A RENTAL MOTOR
5	VEHICLE, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 6-1-201, A CLAIMANT'S DAMAGES ARE
6	LIMITED TO THE ACTUAL LOST PROFITS AS A RESULT OF SUCH LOSS OF USE.
7	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -
8	applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
9	the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
10	general assembly (August 9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10,
11	2017); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
12	(3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
13	or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
14	will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
15	to be held in November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the
16	date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
17	(2) This act applies to causes of action arising on or after the
18	applicable effective date of this act.
