UPDATE PUBLISHING REQMNT DOR TAXES PAID TABLE

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

No Fiscal Impact. This bill removes a statutory reference to the mailing of the income tax booklet by the Department of Revenue (DOR) and instead requires that the disclosure of average taxes paid be made via the DOR's website and its individual income tax filing software. The bill aligns state statute with current

practice.

Summary of Legislation

This bill removes a statutory reference to the mailing of the income tax booklet by the Department of Revenue (DOR) and instead requires that the disclosure of average taxes paid be made via the DOR's website and its individual income tax filing software.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact because it aligns state statute with current practice, and therefore, has no effect on state or local government revenue, expenditures, or workload.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 1, 2018, and takes effect August 8, 2018, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
