PROHIBIT REDUCTION OF SCHOOL FUNDING FY 2020-21 **Bill Topic:**

Summary of Fiscal

Impact:

No fiscal impact. The bill is a legislative declaration to not reduce total program funding or the state share of total program funding appropriated during the 2020 legislative session in the supplemental appropriations process during the 2021

legislative session.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. The bill was not enacted into law;

therefore, the impacts identified in this fiscal note do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

This bill declares that the intent of the General Assembly is to not reduce either total program funding or the state share of total program funding during the supplemental appropriations process in the 2021 legislative session, regardless of actual changes in overall student count, at-risk student count, local property tax revenue, or specific ownership tax revenue.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This bill declares that the intent of the General Assembly is to not reduce total program funding or state aid for K-12 public education from what was appropriated during the 2020 legislative session.-Because legislative declarations are not statutorily binding, the bill does not impact state or local government revenue or expenditures, and therefore, is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House State, Veterans and Military Affairs Committee on November 30, 2020.
