STUDY DETAILS

SUMMARY: This study is for research purposes only. This study involves research to evaluate the effect of an experimental skin care treatment system (treatment lotion, foaming cleanser, shampoo, conditioner, and shave butter) on facial acne, skin pH and sebum content, and skin microbial content over a 21-day period.

BSLI will provide you with a skin care treatment system which you must use through the end of the test period. You must not use any other facial hygiene products on your face. There are no known risks, however this study may involve risks that are unexpected. Beginning on the day you sign up for the study, females must take birth control precautions to avoid becoming pregnant.

STUDY QUALIFICATIONS

- be between 18 and 45 years of age;
- have mild to moderate facial acne, as determined by a trained evaluator at time of consent;
- have ≥ 3 inflammatory facial acne lesions (i.e., surrounded by inflammation [as evidenced by redness]). You must continue to have ≥ 3 inflammatory facial acne lesions on the first day of the laboratory testing (Day 1);
- have facial skin free of non-acne-related injuries / wounds
- be in good general health
- no psoriasis or atopic dermatitis / eczema anywhere on your body;
- no use of topical acne treatments on the face during the 7-day washout period through completion of the 21-day test period
- no use of systemic corticosteroids (including inhaled corticosteroids used for treatment of asthma) within 1 month of consent for this study through completion of the 21-day test period;
- no use of topical corticosteroids on your face within the 7-day washout period through completion of the 21-day test period;
- no use of systemic antibiotics within 1 month of consent for this study through completion of the 21-day test period;
- Female subjects must not have started new hormonal therapy (e.g., birth control) within 3 months of consent for this study.
- No cosmetic facial procedures conducted within 1 month of consent for this study through completion of the 21-day test period;
