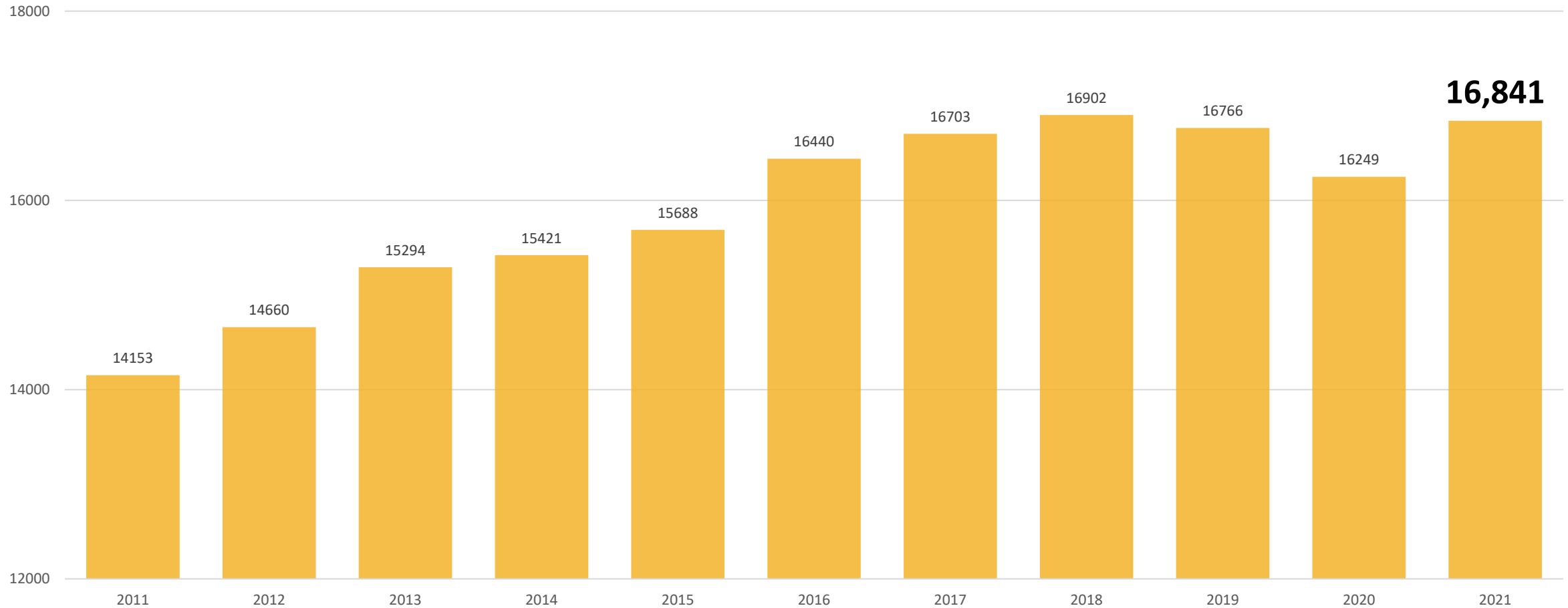

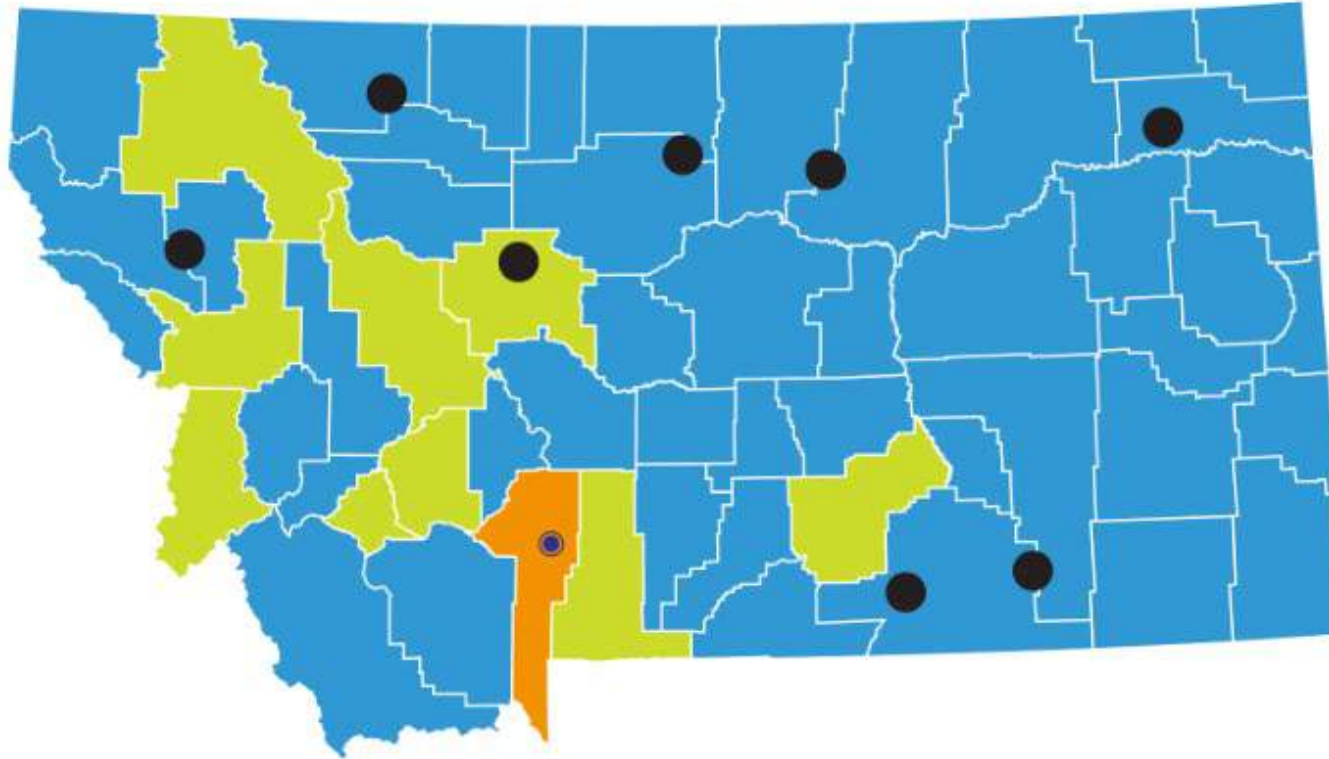
# MSU Enrollment 2011–2021

Fall headcount enrollment has increased over 15% in the past decade.





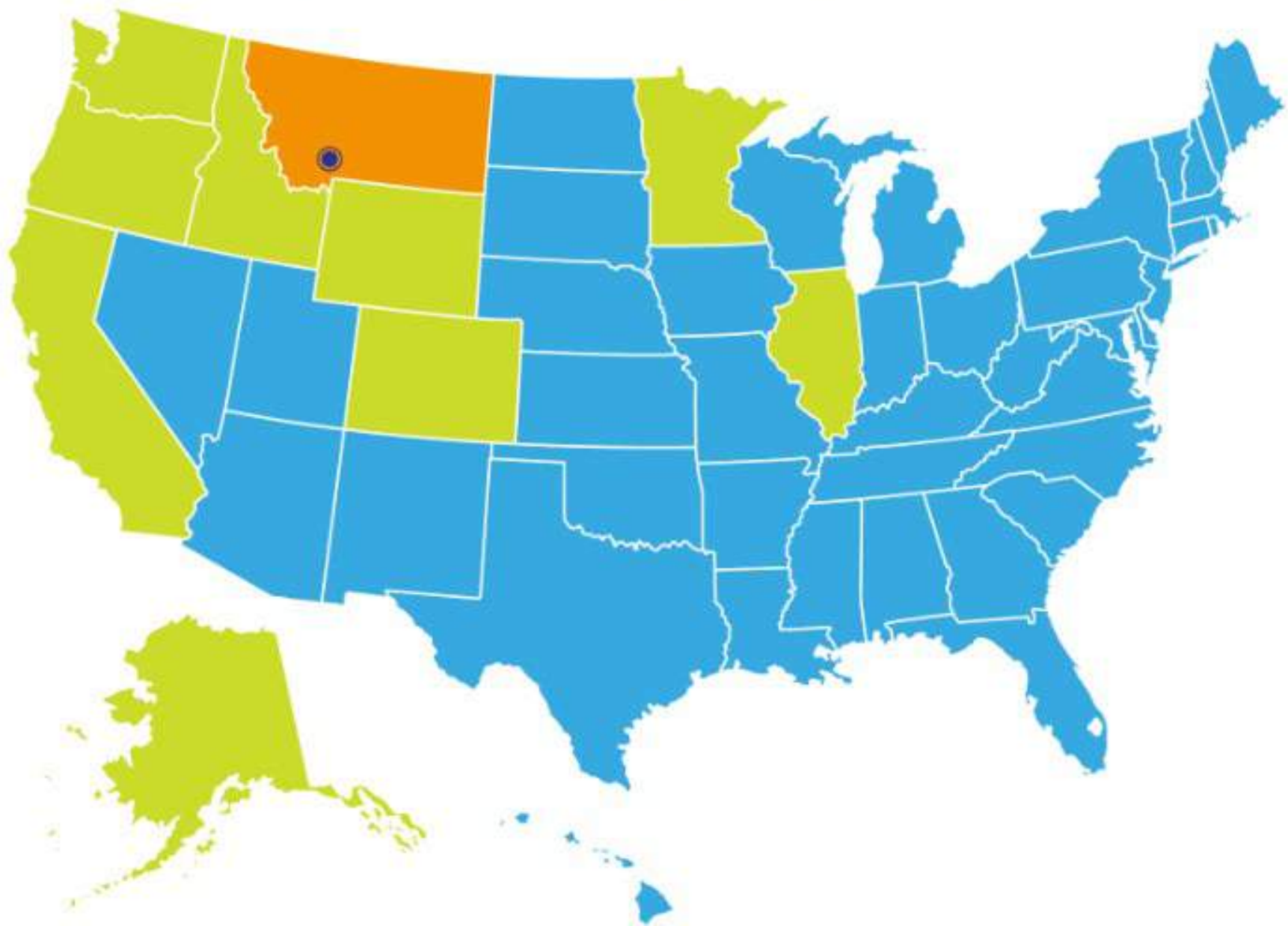

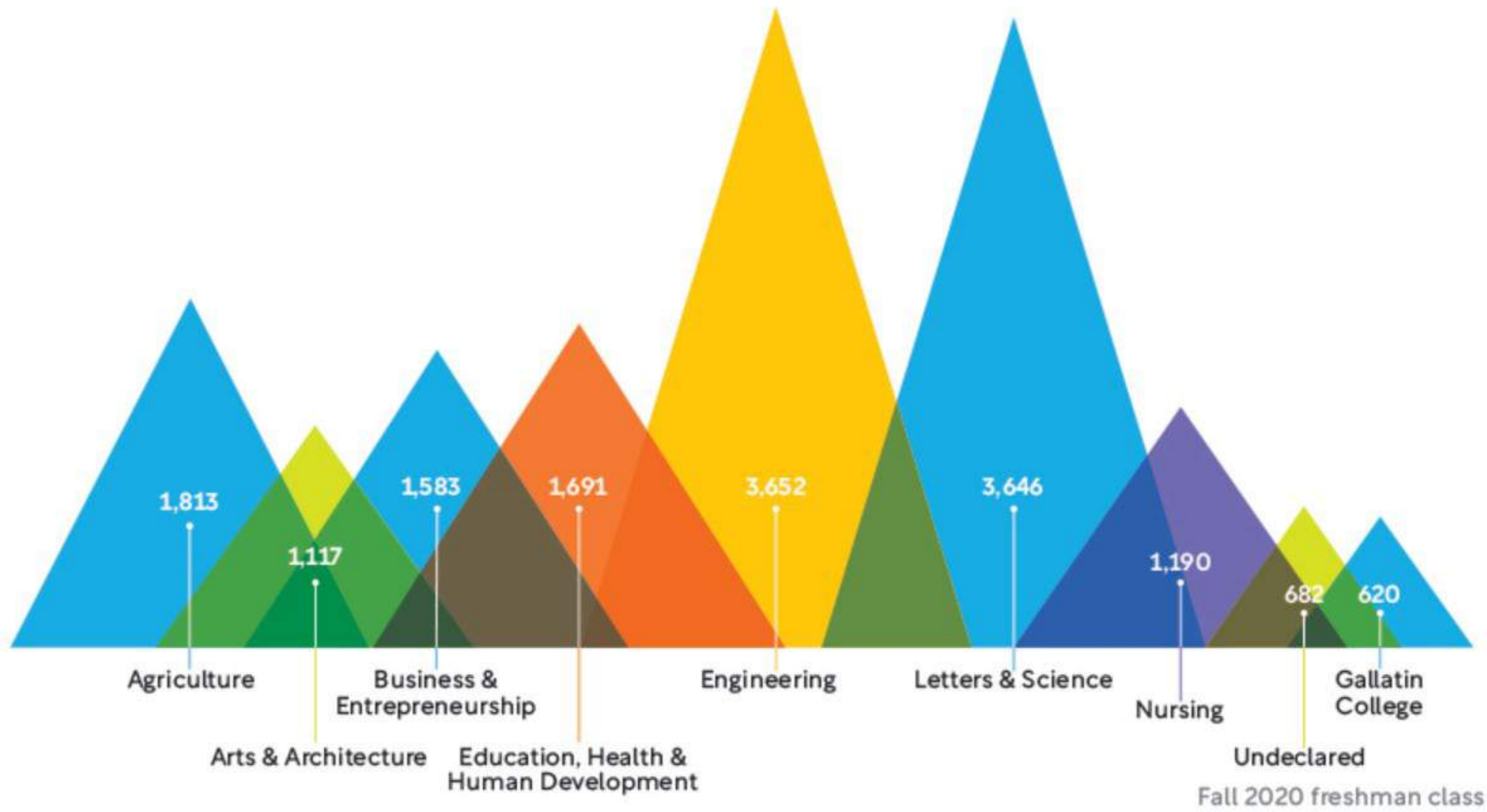
# Students by Country of Origin (2020)

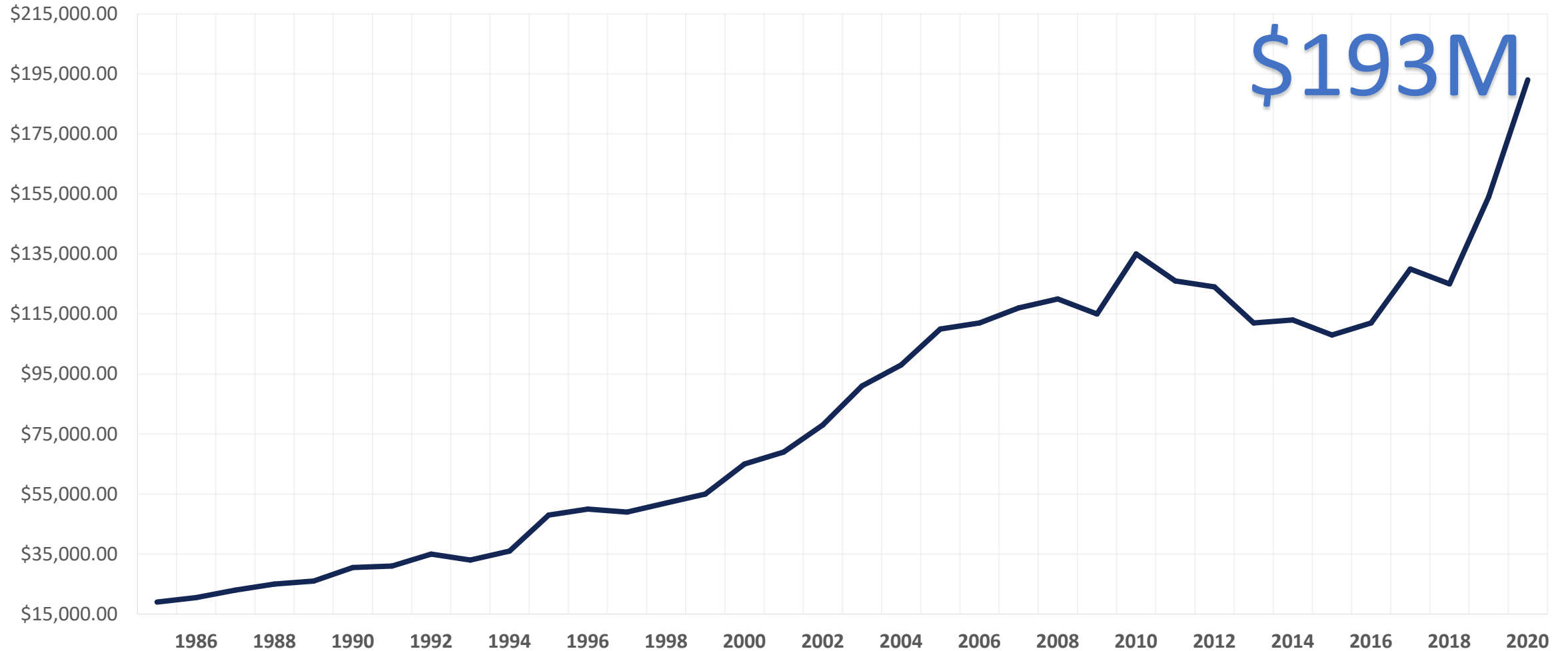

Source: National Science Foundation HERD Survey, 1985–2020



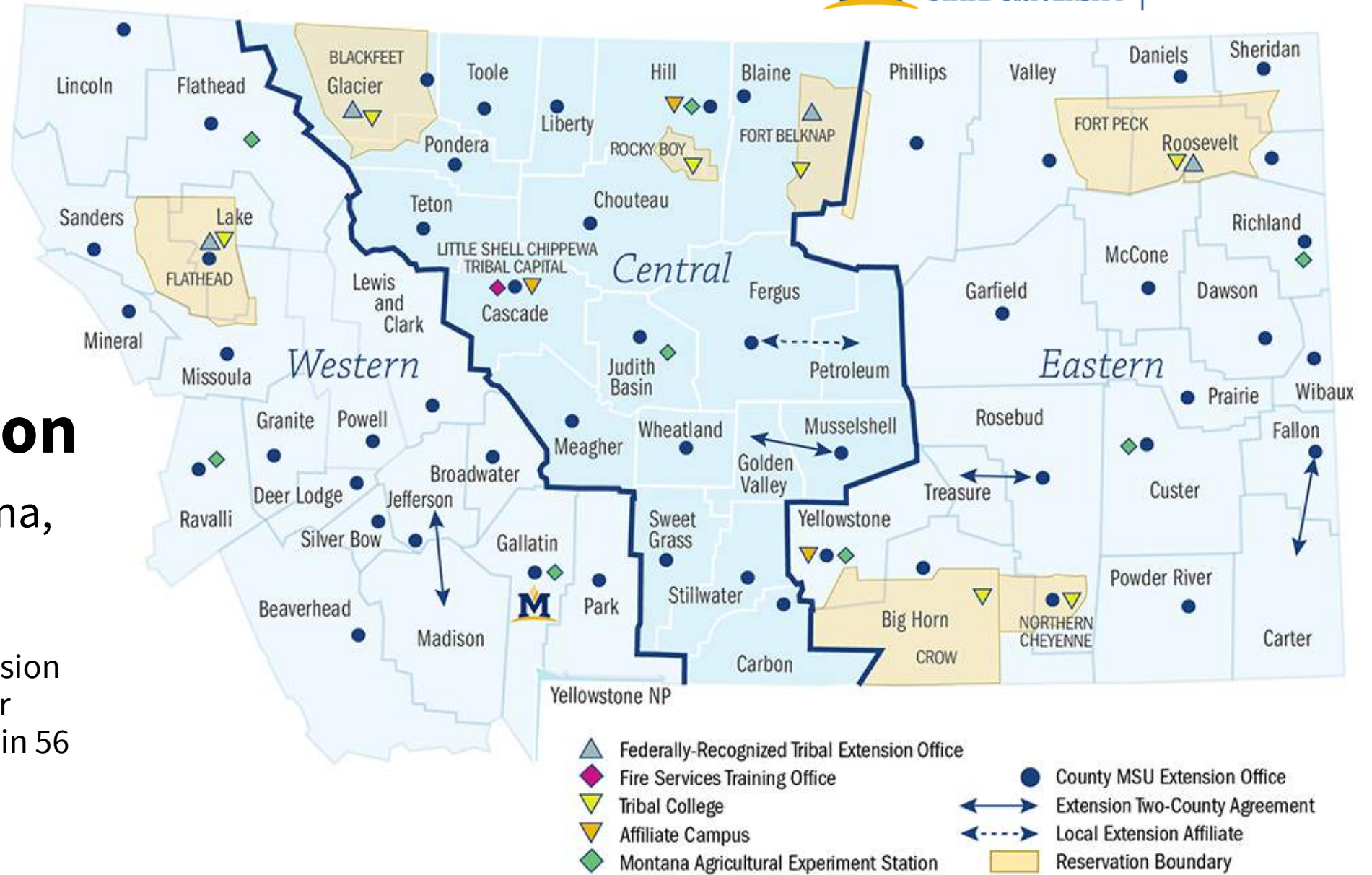

# Economic Impact

- **Approximately 3,800 headcount employees**
- **FY'21 Expenditures of \$667,000,000**
- **FY'22 Budgeted Expenditures of \$713,000,000**
- **Of our fall 2021 enrollment: 5,500 students live on campus and 11,300 live off campus**
  - **Accounts for roughly \$67.8 million to \$108.4 million annually in rent paid into the community**

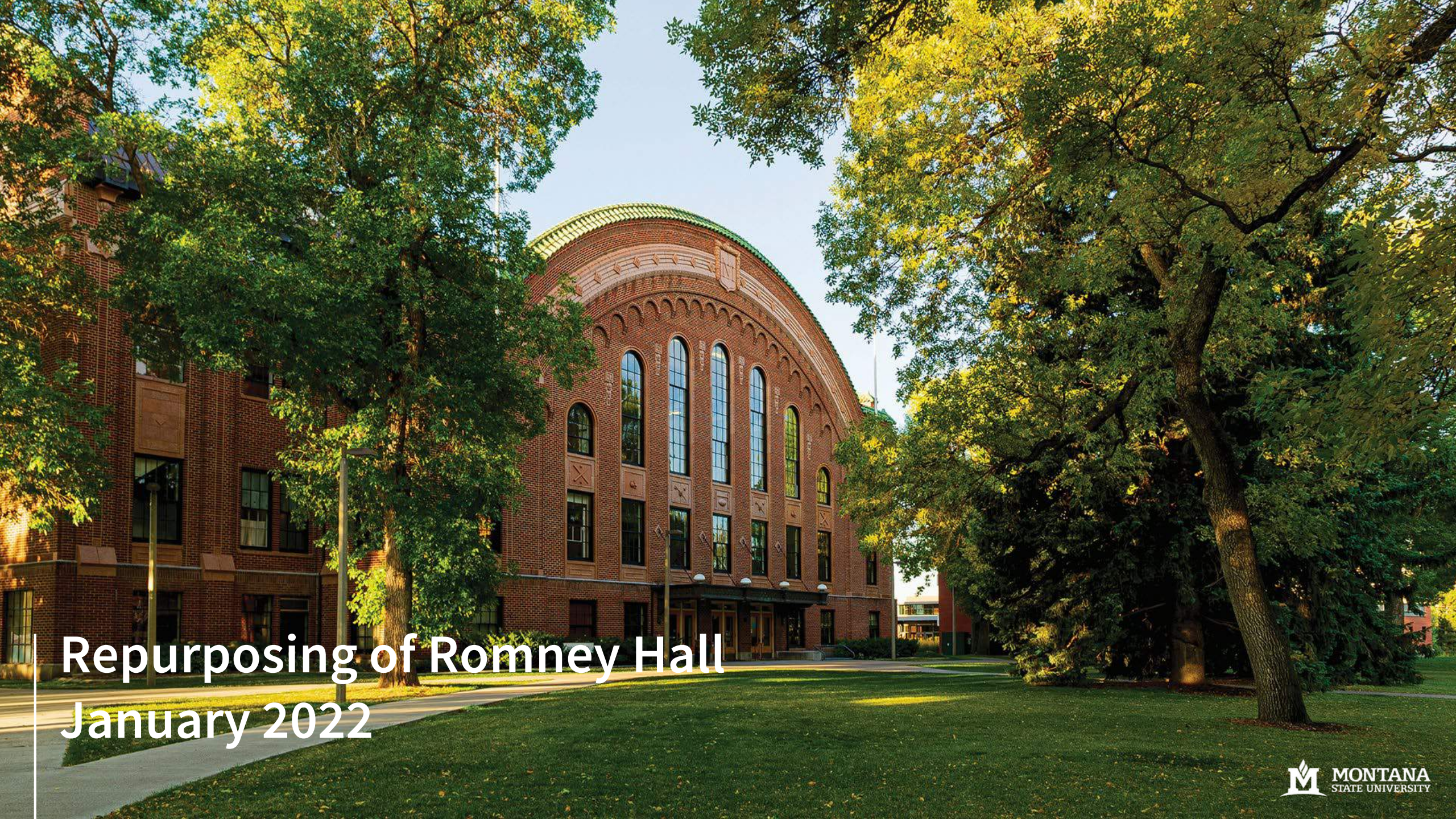

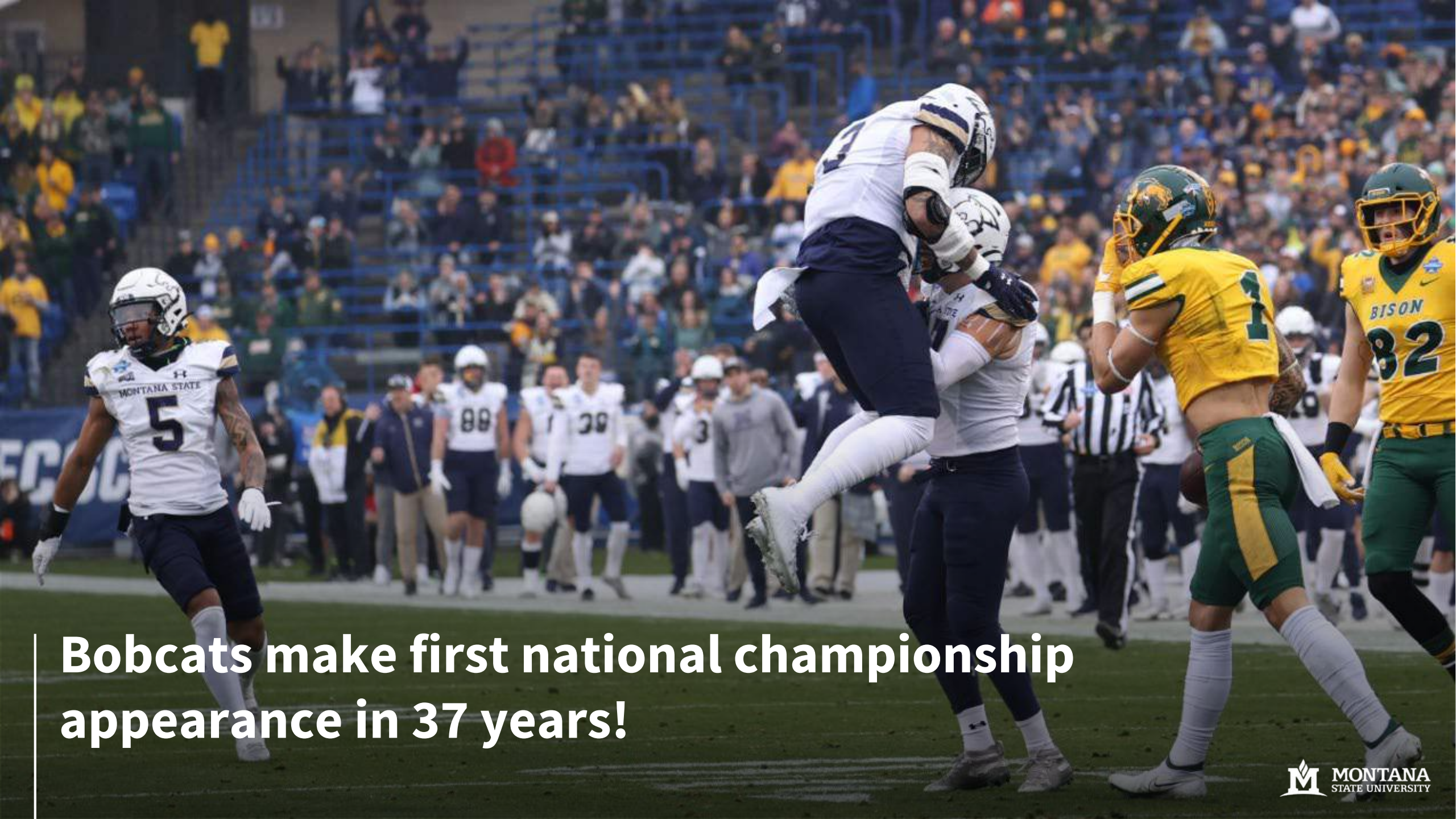
