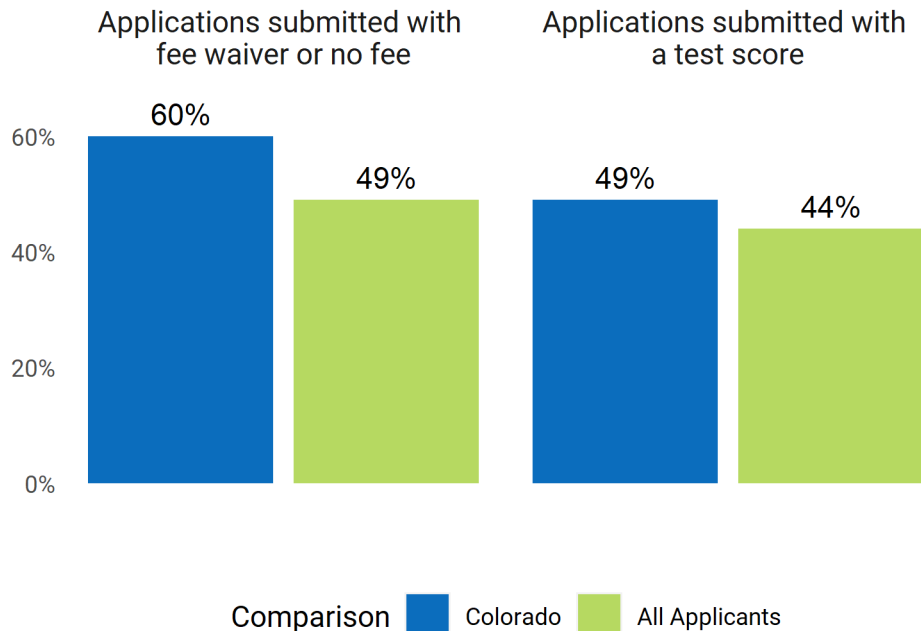

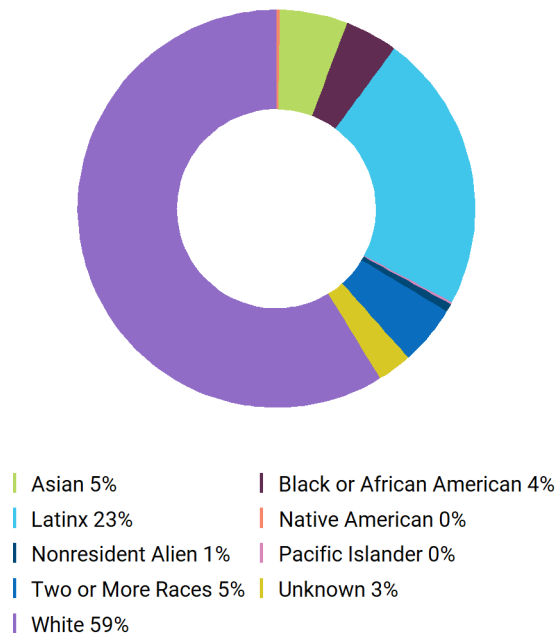

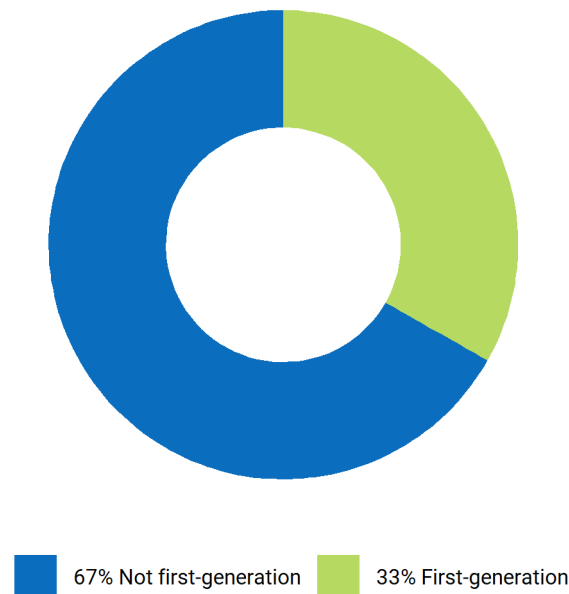
Applicants by Race/Ethnicity

Applicants by First-Generation Status



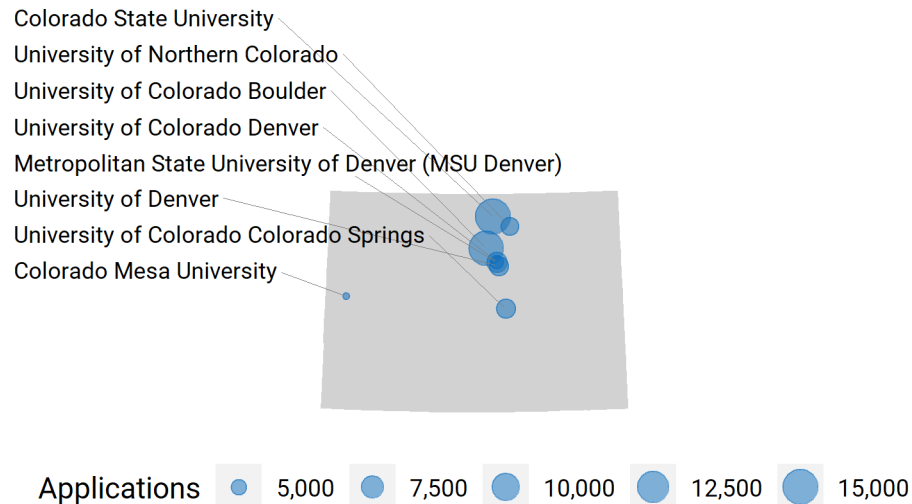

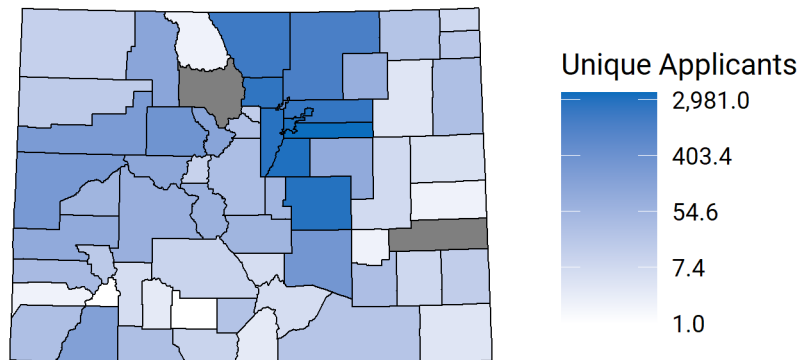

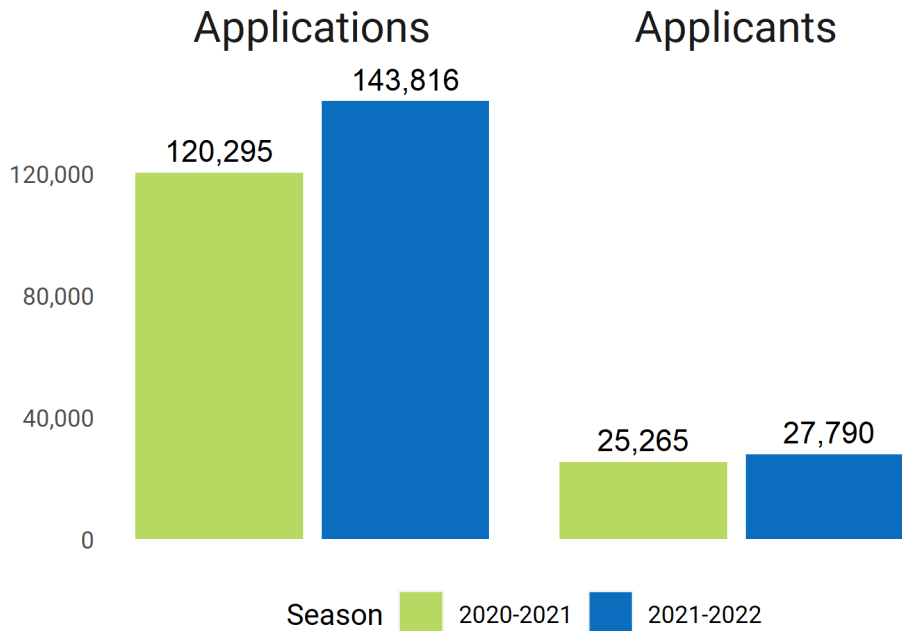
