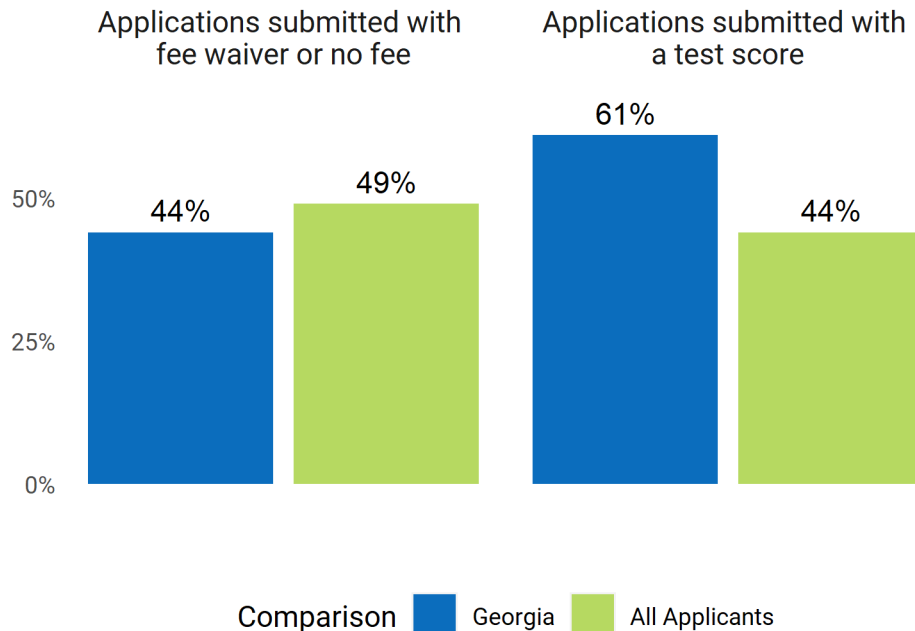

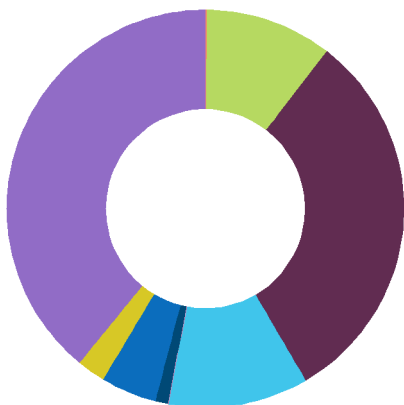

Applicants by Race/Ethnicity



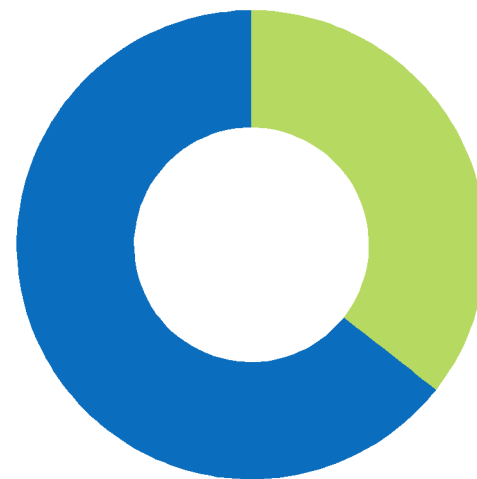

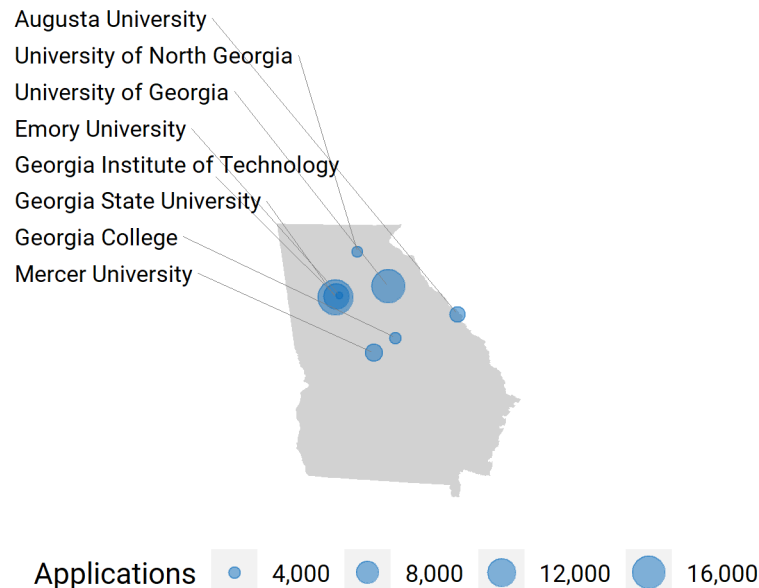

In-State Applications to GA Institutions

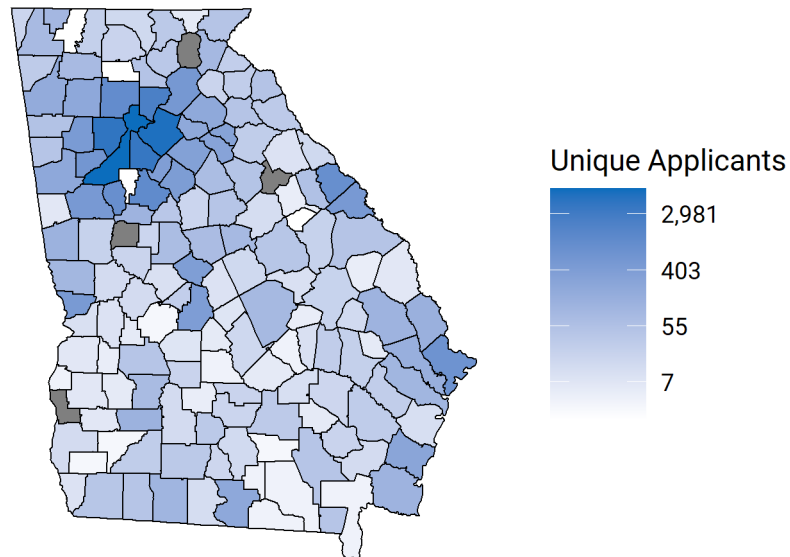

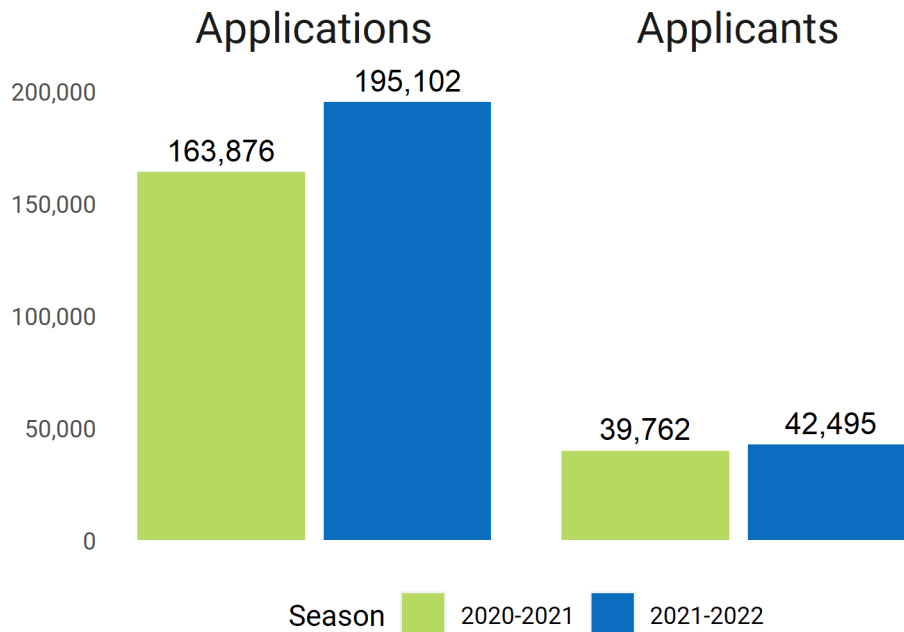
