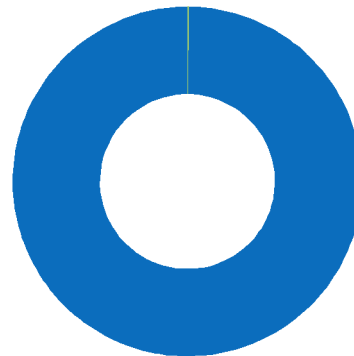

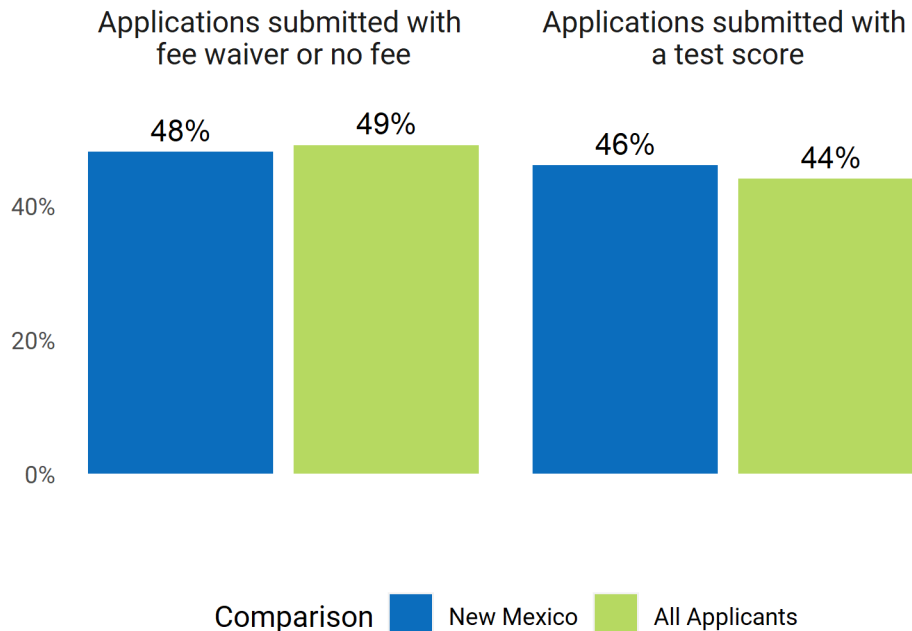

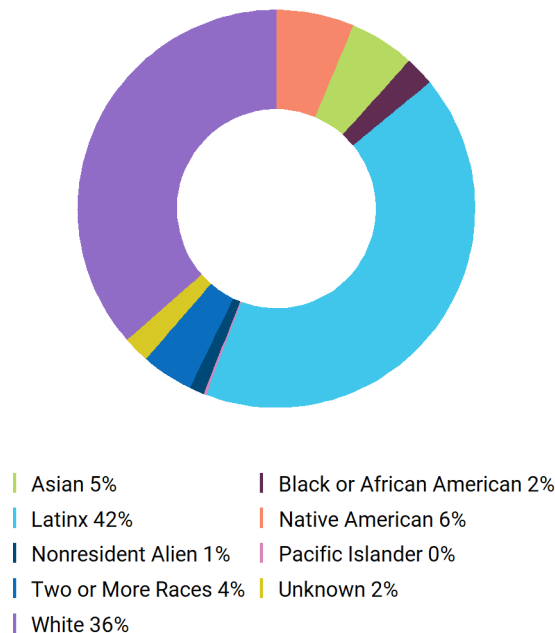

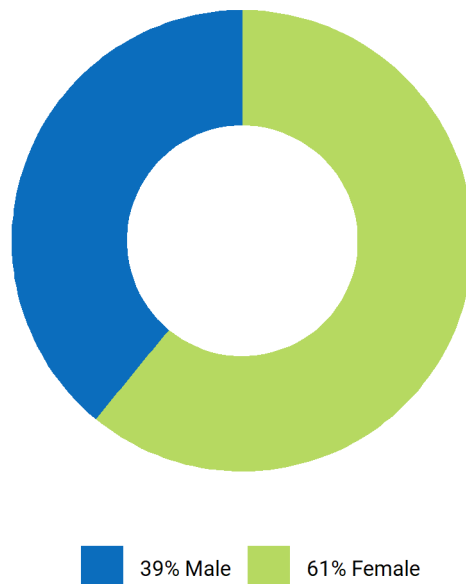

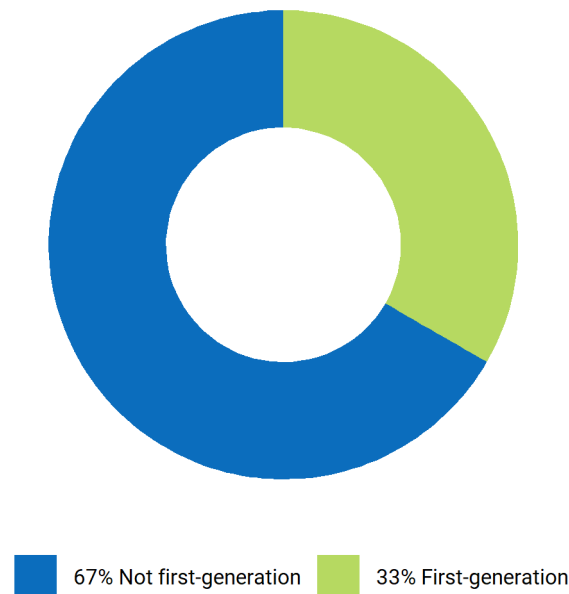
Applicants by Race/Ethnicity

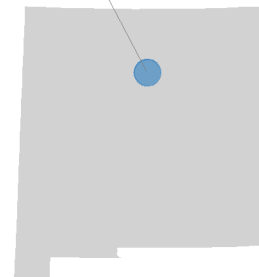

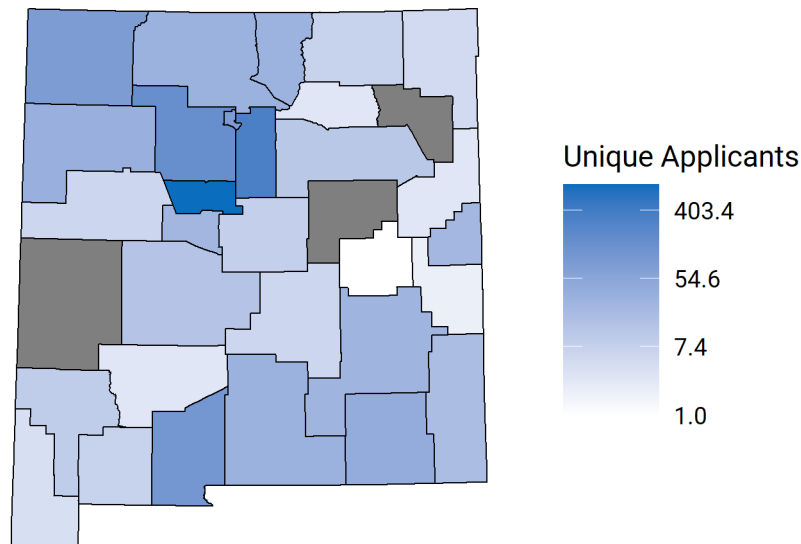

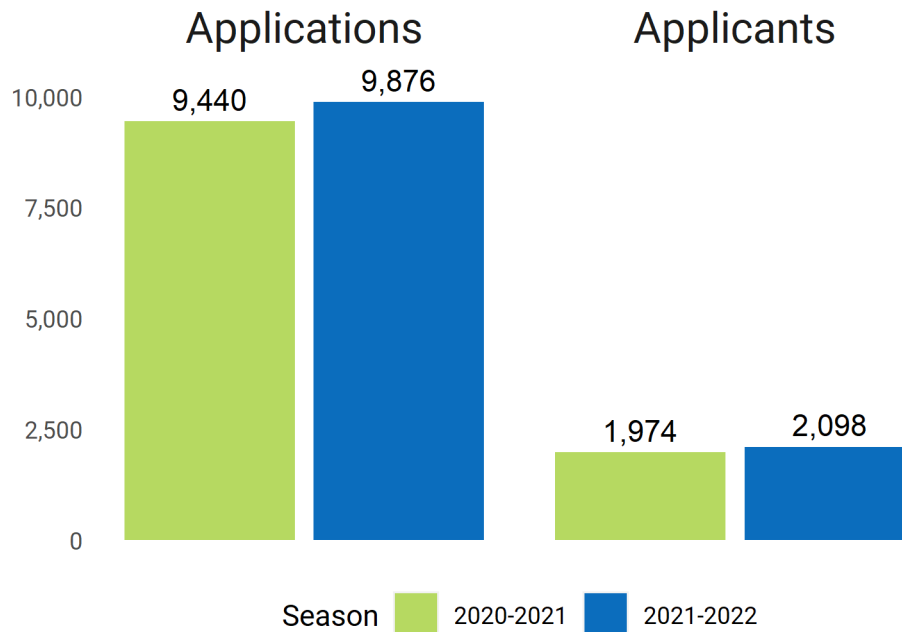
