Selecting the Correct Relay

"Form A" (SPST): Contacts are normally open when the coil of the relay is not energized or there is no magnetic field nearby in a reed switch.

"Form C" (SPDT): Contains 3 leads and would have 1 normally open and 1 normally closed circuit. This is also called a "changeover" device because the common contact changes from the normally closed position to the normally open position when the coil is energized in a Relay or a magnetic field is nearby.

SPST Single Pole, Single Throw
SPDT Single Pole, Double Throw

Note: Non-Sealed Relays are supplied with a snap-in bracket
 Relays without seals can be used with or without the bracket.

Contacts: Normally Open (NO), Normally Closed (NC)

Contact Material: Silver alloy

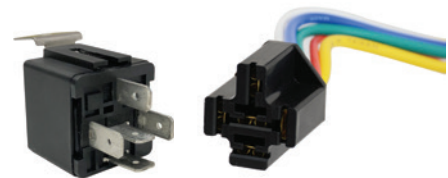
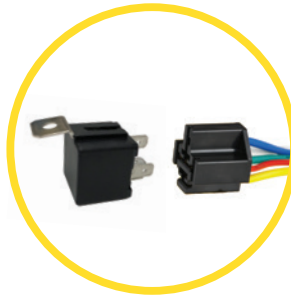

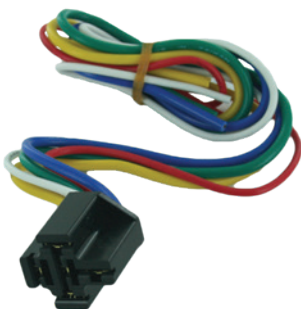
Relays with 5-pin pigtails
