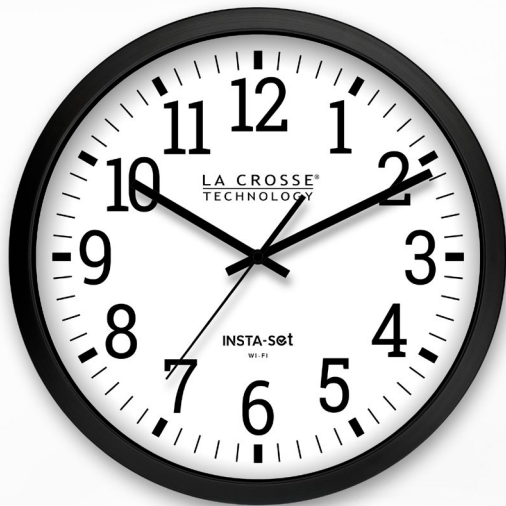


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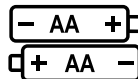
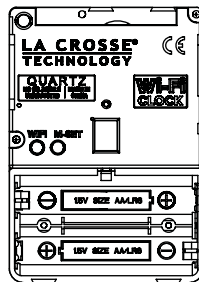
14.1 - Inch Insta-Set Wi-Fi Wall Clock

Power Up

1. Insert 2-AA batteries Into your clock according to polarity markings.
2. Wait until the hands spin and stop at 12:00. Wi-Fi Connection will start.
3. On your phone, open the Wi-Fi Settings and select the **LT CLOCK** network.
4. Follow the prompts on the pop-up window to enter settings.



Pop-up Window

1. Enter your 2.4Ghz Network Name and Password.
2. Use the **CHANGE** button to select your time zone. (Do this even if your Time Zone is already showing).
3. Select your Daylight Saving Time Setting.
AUTOMATIC: Changes Spring and Fall.
DST ON: Daylight Saving Time all year.
DST OFF: Standard Time all year.
4. Select **SAVE**. Your clock will set to network time.

Normal Function

- Your clock will connect one time each day to check the time setting.
- Between Midnight and 6:00am, The Second Hand will stop at 12:00, and not move. This is a battery saving function. The minute and hour hand will continue to move and keep time. The Second hand will start moving again at 6:00am.

Battery Change

- When all three hands stop at 1:50, it is time to replace the batteries.
- After a battery change the hands will move to the 12:00 position. The clock will automatically connect to the same Wi-Fi Network, if the password has not changed.

1. If the clock does not automatically connect, hold the **WIFI** button.
2. On your phone, open the Wi-Fi Settings and select the **LT CLOCK** network.
3. Follow the prompts on the pop-up window to enter settings.

Manual Setting

If the clock goes to 12:00 and does not receive the WIFI signal to set, you can manually set the time.

1. Press and release the **M-SET** button to move the hands slowly. Hold the **M-SET** button to move the hands quickly.
2. Once set the clock will run as a normal quartz clock.

Note: When in manual set mode, remove and reinsert the batteries to return to WIFI mode.
