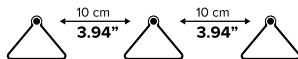
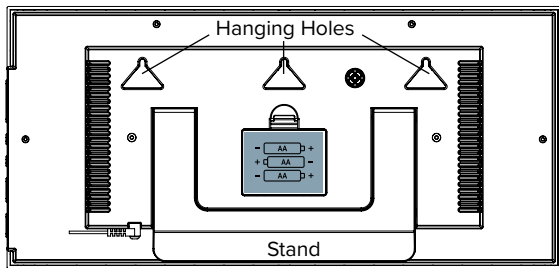


SETUP GUIDE

MODEL: 515-1419v2

## Power Up

1. Insert 3-AA batteries into your Atomic Clock.
2. Use the Intergrated Hanging Holes to mount on a wall or use the pull out stand to place on a table.



### HANGING INSTRUCTIONS

*In the location you would like to hang the clock, mark three level spots, each 3.94"/10 cm apart. Use your preferred fastener to install clock.*

## Atomic Time

- Your Clock will automatically search for the Atomic Time Signal at UTC 7:00, 8:00, 9:00, 10:00, and 11:00.
- Press and release the - (**MINUS**) button to manually start or stop a search for the WWVB Atomic Time Signal.
- While searching, the Tower Icon (🗼) will flash. The Tower Icon will be solid when the WWVB Signal is received by your clock.

## Settings Menu

1. Hold the **MODE** button until the display changes to enter the Settings Menu.
2. Press and release the **+** or **-** button to adjust values.
3. Press and release the **MODE** button to confirm and move to next menu item.
4. Press and release the **TIME ADVANCE** button at any time to exit.

### Settings order:

- Beep ON/OFF
- Atomic ON/OFF
- Daylight Saving Time: AUT/ ON / OFF
- Time Zone
- 12/24 Format
- Hour
- Minutes
- Year
- Month
- Date
- Month/Date or Date/Month
- Fahrenheit/Celsius



### Daylight Saving Time Settings

- AUT = Changes Spring and Fall
- ON = DST all year
- OFF = Standard Time All year


### Time Zones

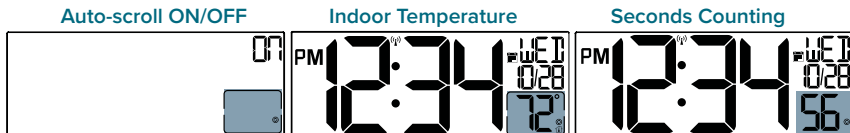
- AT = Atlantic
- ET = Eastern
- CT = Central
- MT = Mountain
- PT = Pacific
- AKT = Alaska
- HAT = Hawaii

**Atomic Off:** When Atomic Off is selected, you will move directly to the 12/24 Hour setting.

**Weekday:** Weekday will set automatically when the Year, Month and Date are set.


## Custom Display

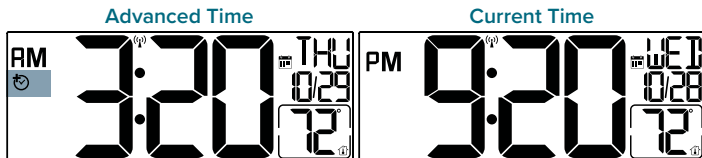
- Press and release the **MODE** button to toggle between Seconds, Indoor Temperature, or Auto-scroll Temperature and Seconds.
- The Auto-scroll Indicator  will lose one segment every second, for 5 seconds, then switch to the next item.



## Time Advance

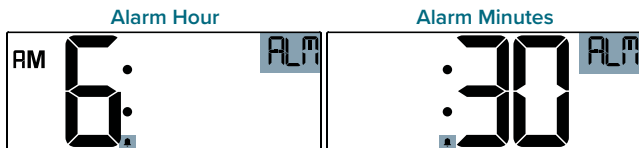
Use the Time Advance feature to easily view the time in another part of the world.

1. Hold the **TIME ADVANCE** button until the hour begins flashing.
2. Use the **+ (PLUS)** button to adjust the secondary time zone to one ahead of yours (+1 to +12) or the **- (MINUS)** button to set it to one behind (-1 to -12).
3. Press and release the **TIME ADVANCE** button to confirm and toggle between advanced time and current time. The Time Advance Icon  will show when viewing this mode.



## Time Alarm

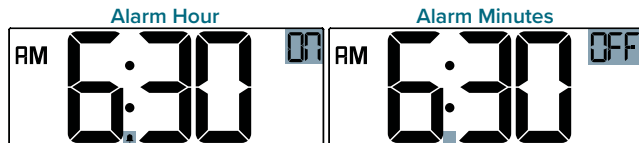
1. Hold the **ALARM** button to enter alarm settings. **ALM** will show and the hour will flash.
2. Press and release the **+** or **-** button to choose the hour.
3. Press and release the **ALARM** button to confirm and move to the minutes. Minutes will flash.
4. Press and release the **+** or **-** button to choose the minutes.
5. Press and release the **ALARM** button to confirm and exit.
6. Press the **TIME ADVANCE** button at any time to exit.



## Activate/Deactivate Alarm

The alarm is active when set. The Alarm Icon 🔔 will show.

1. Press and release the **ALARM** button to view alarm time.
2. When viewing alarm time, press the **ALARM** button to activate or deactivate the alarm.




## Snooze

When the alarm sounds, press and the **ALARM** button to silence the alarm for 10 minutes. The Snooze Icon **Zz** will flash.



## Silence a Sounding Alarm

When the alarm sounds, press any button except the ALARM button to silence the alarm for 24-hours. The alarm will sound the next day at the set time. The Alarm Icon  will continue to show.

## Low Battery Icon

- When the Low Battery Icon  appears by the time, replace batteries.

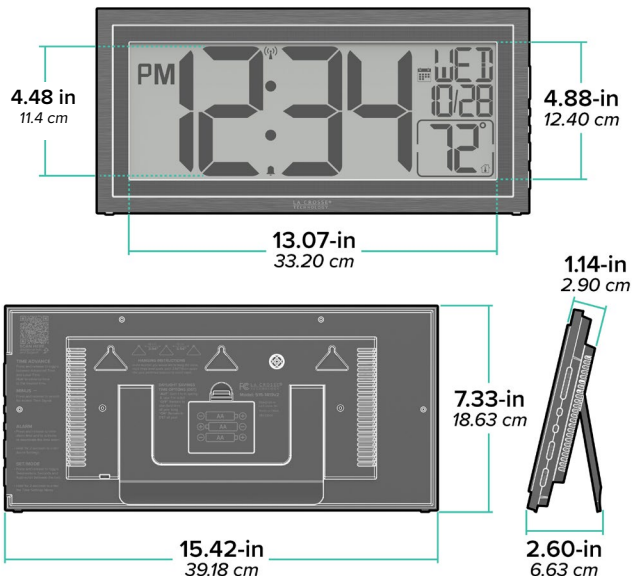
