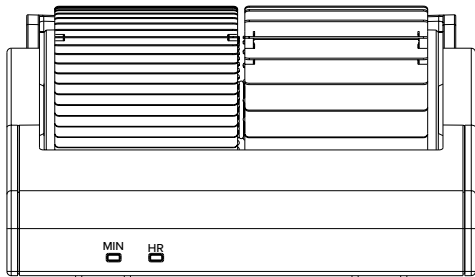
**ROLLINS MINI
MECHANICAL FLIP CLOCK**

Initial Setup

1. Insert one, AA battery into the bottom of the clock.
2. The time cards will begin to flip. Wait until a full cycle is complete, stopping at 12:00 AM before setting the time.
3. Use the instructions below to manually set the time.



Set Time

1. Hold the **MIN** and **HR** button together to enter setting mode.
2. Press and release the **HR** button to set the hour. Hold to set quickly.
2. Press and release the **MIN** button to set the minutes. Hold to set quickly.
3. The clock will start running and flip the cards to keep time.

Time Backup

Your clock's time setting will be saved for up to 3 hours in the event of battery failure. Once a fresh battery is installed the clock will first flip to 12:00 AM, then set the time..

For an extended period without a working battery, use the instructions above to manually reset the time.

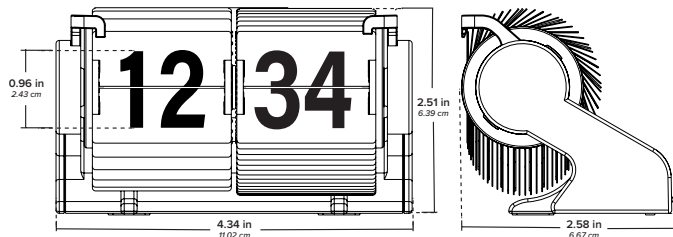
