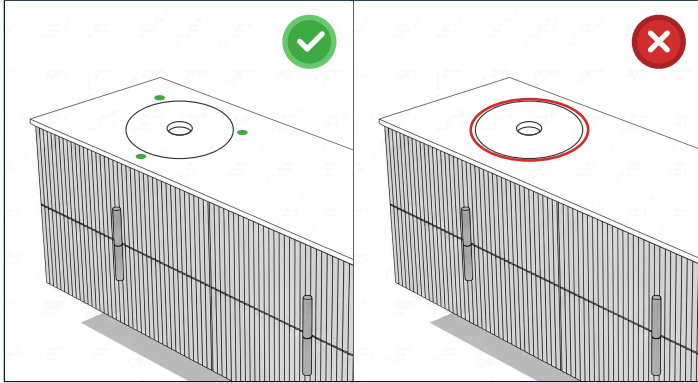


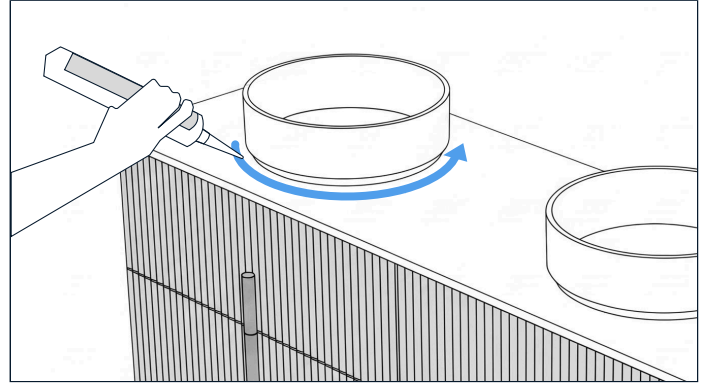
ABOVE COUNTER BASINS

Note: Keeping the silicone underneath to a minimum, as set out below, means the basin can be lifted out later without damaging your benchtop for future updates.



There are two separate jobs for silicone here: a small amount underneath to hold the basin in place, and a seal around the outer rim to keep water out. It helps to keep them distinct.

Underneath the basin, apply 20mm dots of a non-acidic silicone at no more than three fixing points. This secures its position while still allowing for easy removal down the track. Important: Epoxy type glues must not be used.

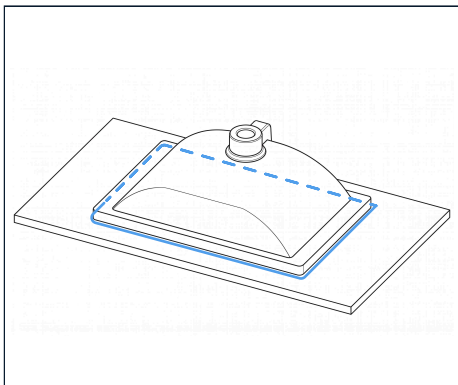


Now seal the join between the basin and the benchtop. Run a continuous bead of silicone around the outer rim, where the basin meets the benchtop, so water can't get into the cavity below. Match the silicone to the colour of the basin as closely as you can, so the finished line sits neatly against it.

Wipe away any excess silicone with a soft, damp cloth.

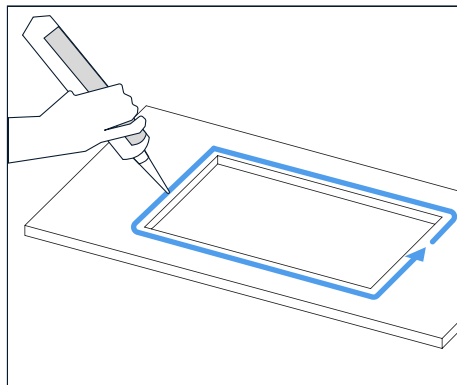
UNDER-COUNTER BASINS

Note: It is important to check benchtop manufacturers recommendations and adjust the following steps to suit.



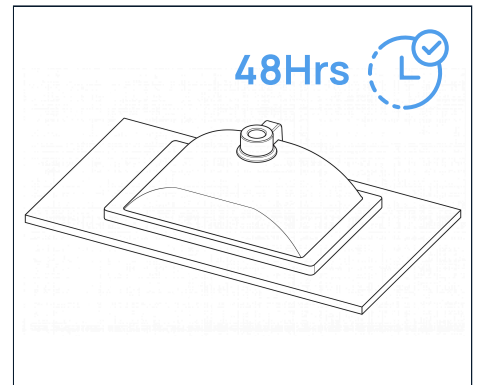
Lay the benchtop flat with the underside facing up. Clean the underside of the sealing rim to ensure it is free of dust, dirt and grease. Sit the basin evenly over the cut-out and trace its outline with a marker, so you have a reference for the steps that follow.

Important: If you're fitting a bench-mounted basin mixer, leave enough room at the back or side to tighten the mixer fixing.



Using an approved, flexible and water-tight adhesive, run a continuous bead around the cut-out, between the edge of the cut-out and the line you marked, where the rim of your basin will sit. Do not use epoxy or any other solid adhesive or acidic silicone.

Lower the basin onto the adhesive, lining it up with your marked outline.



Leave to dry face-down for minimum of 48 hours, or longer in cold weather. Once dried and secure, the benchtop is ready to install.
