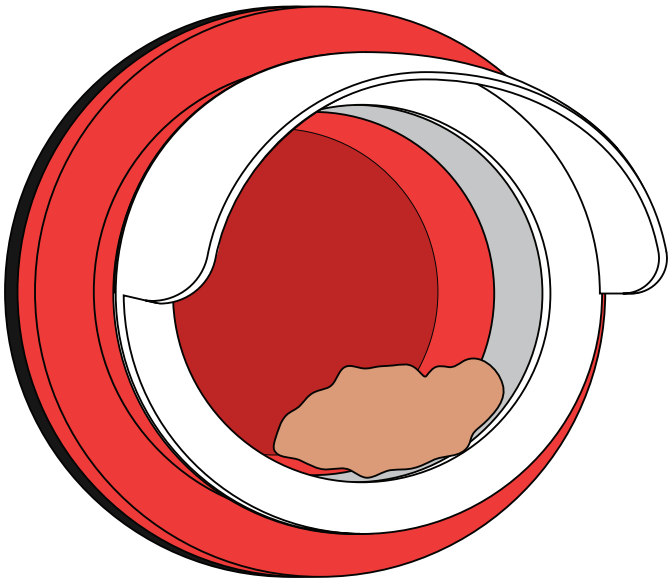
DETERMINING FEEDER HEIGHT



The bottom of the feed port should be at your smallest chicken's shoulder-height.

TRAINING CHICKENS TO USE THE FEEDER

IMPORTANT:
YOU MUST REMOVE THE OLD SOURCE OF FEED AND PUT THIS FEEDER IN ITS PLACE IN ORDER FOR CHICKENS TO BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THEIR NEW FEEDING SOURCE.



Pour feed into the port so that the feed is visible to the chickens.
You only have to do this step once.

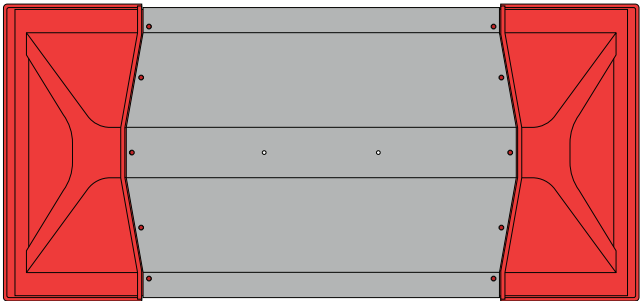
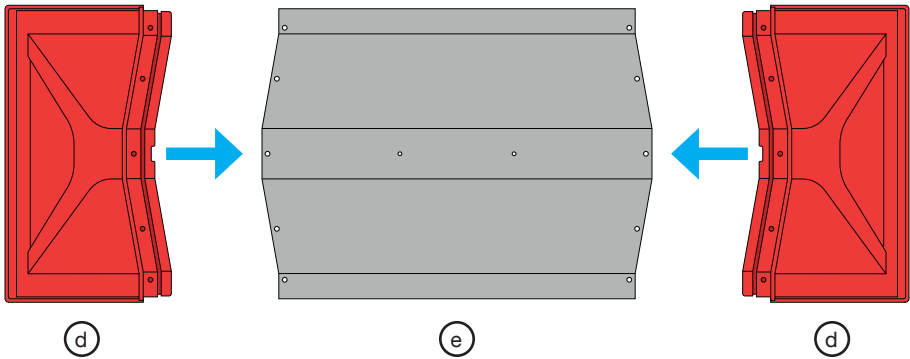
INSTRUCTIONS: HOW TO ASSEMBLE

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- drill (recommended)
- screwdriver



1. Assemble the feeder lid by sliding the two end pieces (d) under piece (e).

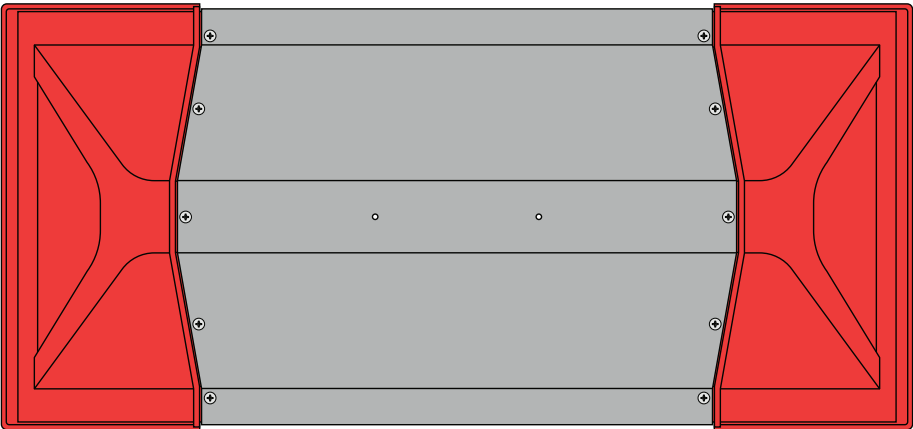
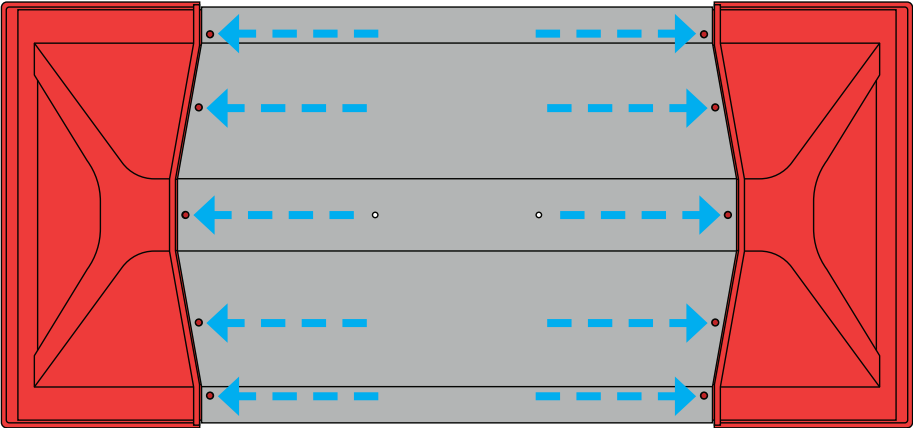


2. Secure the feeder lid pieces together with 10 screws (h).

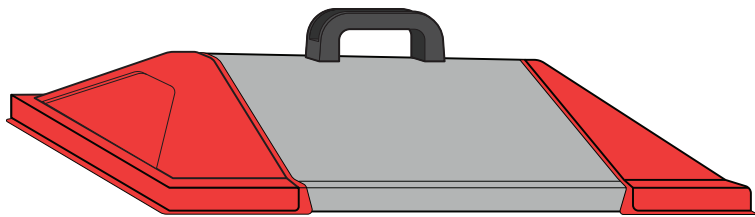
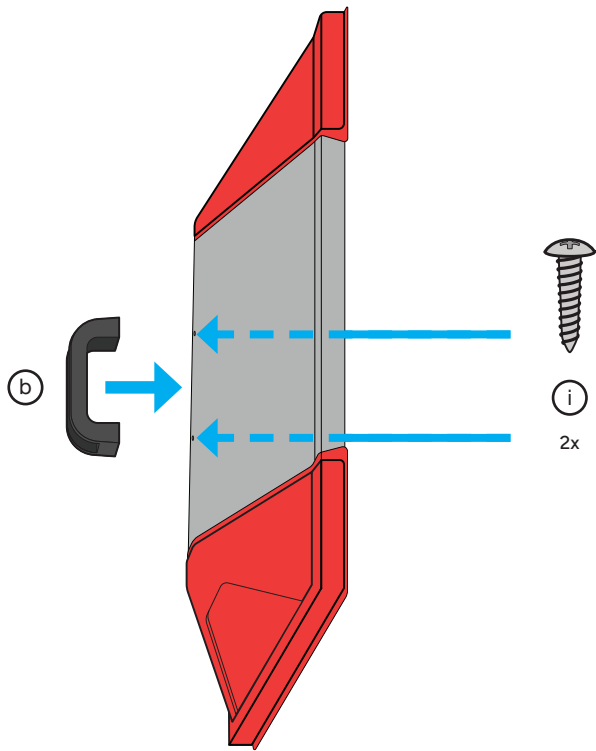

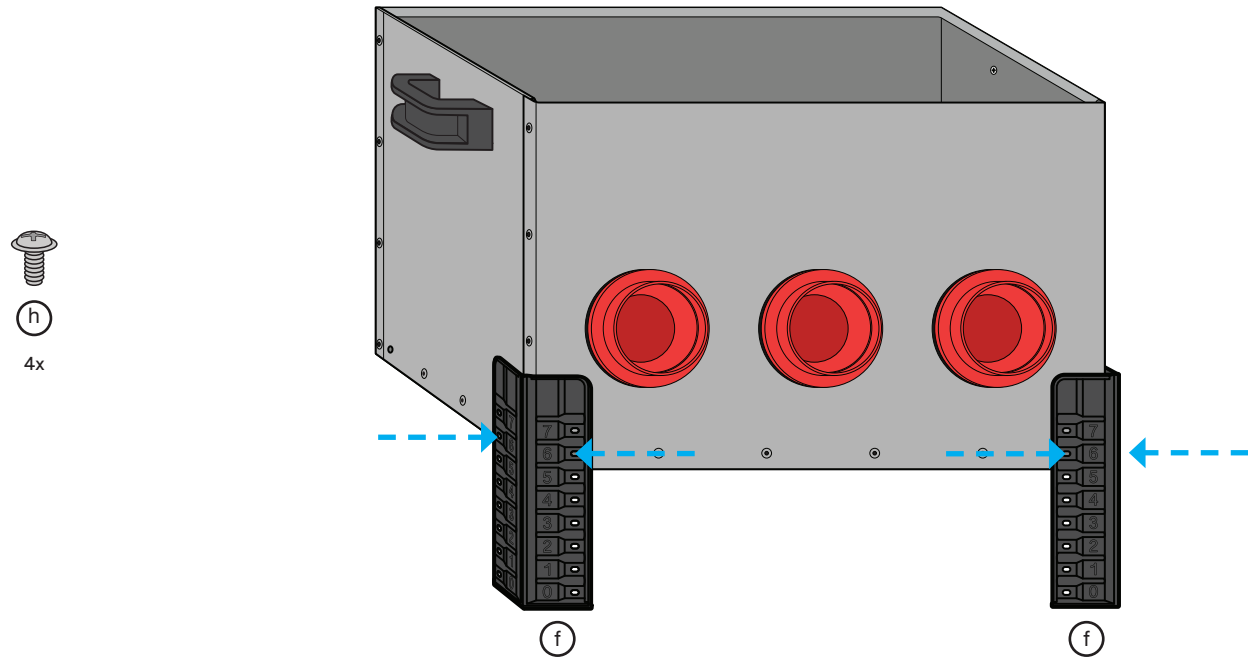
3. Install a handle (b) on the feeder lid using two screws (i).



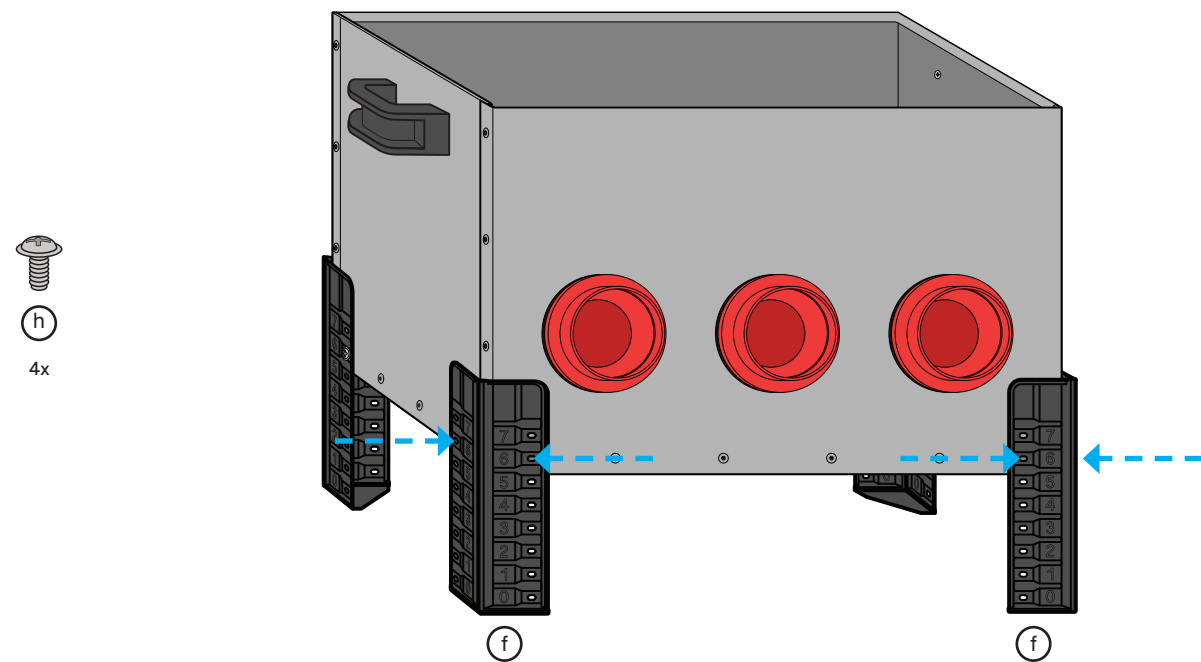
4. Install remaining two handles (b) onto the feeder (a) using 4 screws (i).



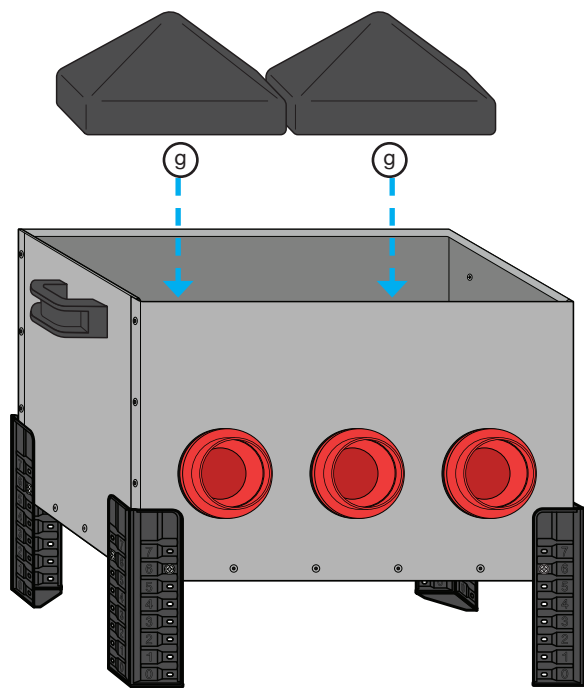
5. Determine the height of the desired height on the feeder before installing legs (see page 3). Lay the feeder down on its back and attach two of the four legs (f) onto the feeder using the other provided screws (h).



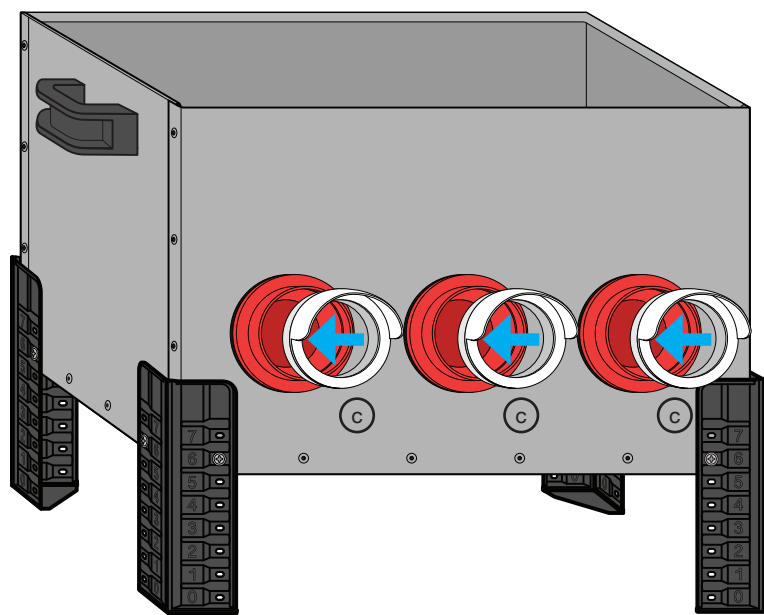
6. Flip the feeder onto the other side and install the remaining two legs (f) on the opposite side using the remaining 4 screws (h).



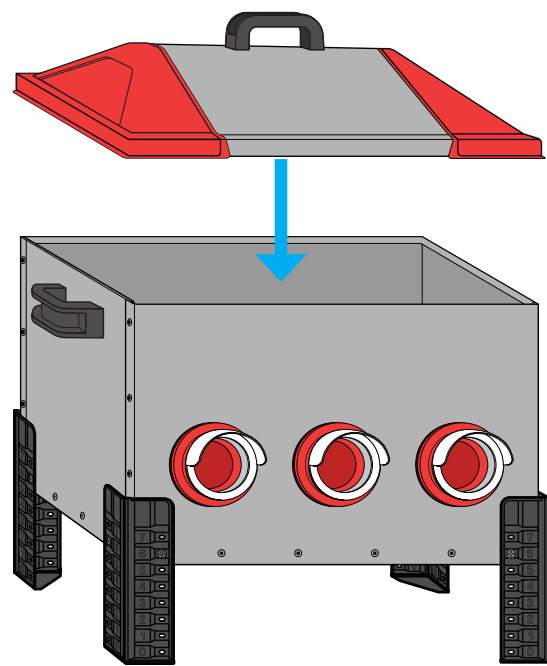
7. Insert feed diverters (g) into feeder.



8. Stand the feeder upright and install the six rain hoods(c) by pushing them into the feed ports. The rain hoods will fit snug inside the feed ports.



9. Fill with feed and cover with lid.





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
