
# **SAFE-T LADDER GATE**

## **Instructions for Assembly**

× Do not throw instructions away.

A Read and understand instructions before using this equipment.



- Meets or exceeds: OSHA 1910.29 & 1926.502
- Materials: Powder-coated aluminum.
- Components: (4) Allen Screws (4mm or 5/32 in)
  - (2) Brackets
  - (1) Safety Ladder Gate)
- **WARNING** NEVER move, shift, or extend ladder when in use.
- **A WARNING** NEVER carry loads that may cause loss of balance.
- **A WARNING** NEVER modify or misuse Safety Ladder Gate.
- **WARNING** Areas around top and bottom of ladder must be kept clear.
- **WARNING** One hand must always grasp a ladder rung during climbing.



- ▲ NOTE Adhere to ladder slope requirements (4:1, vertical/horizontal).
- A NOTE Top rung step of ladder must be in line with landing platform.
- ▲ NOTE ONLY use in combination with #10800 Safe-T Ladder Extension System.
- ▲ NOTE Ladder MUST be secured to landing platform to use Safety Ladder Gate.
- NOTE Only use ladder on stable and level surfaces.

### **Prepare Gate for Installation**

Step 1

Grip bottom (long) gate bracket attachment point on gate.

Step 2

Rotate gate past 360° to load self-closing mechanism.

Step 3

DO NOT allow gate to release during installation.

#### Installation

Step 1

Install prior to using ladder. NEVER install while climbing.

Step 2

Place pre-loaded place Safety Ladder Gate on Safe-T Ladder Extension System rail that will face toward intended work surface. Ensure top of Safety Ladder Gate will be 42 in (+/- 3 in) above work surface.

Step 3

Attach Safety Ladder Gate brackets. Two Allen screws MUST be used per bracket. Tighten all Allen screws with compatible Allen wrench (4mm or 5/32 in) until hand-tight.

Step 4

Ensure that gate self-closing mechanism is functional and properly loaded by opening gate and allowing it to close. Reinstall if gate does not self-close.

Step 5

Secure ladder to landing platform and ensure it will withstand MINIMUM 200 lb outward force applied to top rail of Safety Ladder Gate.
