Keeping the carabiner so that the screw collar is away from your body slide the tip of the desired belt through the opening of the belt adaptor. Continue sliding into the desired location which provides the most comfort and convenience.



Open the carabiner gate by unscrewing the screw collar counterclockwise and insert the tether attachment point (D-Ring, Key Ring, etc.) of the tool onto the carabiner. Once in place be sure to screw the collar clockwise until tight into place preventing the carabiner from inadvertently opening.



Once in place choose the desired tether ready tools to connect to the carabiners.



When needing to use a tool start by unscrewing the screw collar in a counterclockwise direction and then open the gate allowing the tool to be removed from the carabiner.

**NOTE: Do not attach tool tethers directly to the carabiners, for stowing tools only.
