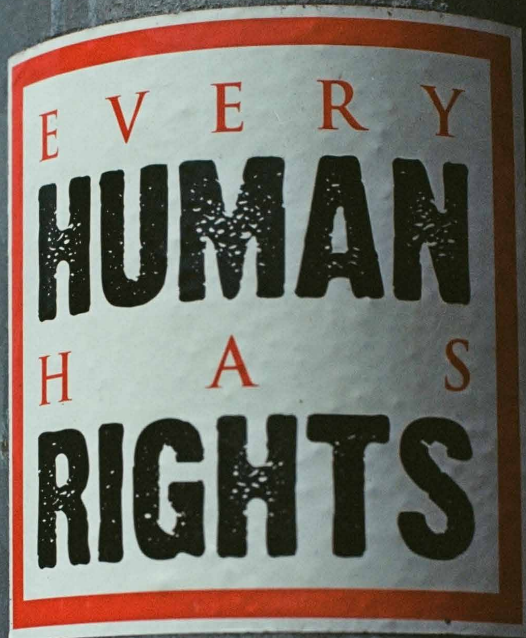




# HUMAN TRAFFICKING

No business may retaliate against any person as a reprisal for the person having made a good-faith report of Human Trafficking or for the person discussing a suspected act of Human Trafficking.
