

# POP UP LANTERN & FLASHLIGHT

## **SETUP**



**1.** To open battery compartment: Unscrew cap in counter-clockwise direction as indicated and separate.



3 x AA batteries



2. Insert batteries into the battery compartment. Insert with correct polarity (+ and -) as shown in the battery compartment.

**3.** To close battery compartment: Line up slots on cap with receivers on inside of battery compartment. Push down and screw in clockwise direction as indicated.

### **OPERATION**



**Lantern:** Slide open housing. Lantern will automatically turn on. Close housing to turn off.



**Flashlight:** Push button to turn on. Push button a second time to turn off.

## **CONVERTIBLE HANDLE**





Convertible handle allows the Pop Up Lantern & Flashlight to be held vertically or horizontally.

Pinch handle connector to release from connection points. Lift over top of lantern, pinch connector again to insert into connection points.
